### HEAD COACH ERV HUNT

Erv Hunt begins his 31st season at California and 30th as head coach. Since 1992, Hunt has overseen Cal's men's and women's track & field programs as director of track & field. In addition to building Cal's men's program into national prominence with three Top 10 finishes at the NCAA Championship, Hunt served as the U.S. men's head track & field coach at the 1996 Olympics. Hunt is Cal's third Olympic track coach, the most ever for one university.

**CAL TRAVELS TO NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS:** Six Cal athletes travel to Baton Rouge, La., May 29-June 1 to compete in the 2002 NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships. They are seniors **Jennifer Joyce** (hammer, discus), **Erin Belger** (800m), **Missy Vanek** (heptathlon), **Marielle Schlueter** (3000mSC), **Bubba McLean** (pole vault) and junior **Sheni Russell** (discus). Louisiana State serves as host of this year's championships. USC won the 2001 women's title, and Tennessee claimed the men's trophy.

**BEARS NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS HISTORY:** In 2001, the Cal men finished 22nd at the NCAA Championships with 12 points, eight from Bolota Asmerom (5000m, 2nd) and four from **Bubba McLean** (PV, 5th, then-PR of 17-10.5). The Bear women tied for 60th as a team with their only two points coming from Maria Lopez (PV, 7th). Cal's highest men's finish at NCAAs was second in 1943 and 1959, while its highest women's was 11th in 1987 and 1990.

**2002 PAC-10 CHAMPIONSHIPS IN REVIEW:** Cal had a disappointing Pac-10 Championships with the women finishing eighth with 44 points and the men a program worst of ninth with 22 points. As with most of the season, the Bear men didn't have many of their marquee athletes available due to injuries (i.e. Robert Kennedy (long jump) and Rhuben Williams (shot put, hammer)). While the Bears regularly posted a ton of PRs each week during the season, they didn't perform at their best at Pac-10s, tallying a combined five PRs. The Stanford men and the UCLA women repeated as champions.

**JOYCE WINS ELUSIVE PAC-10 HAMMER TITLE:** **Jennifer Joyce** won the Cal women's first individual conference title in two years with her victory in the hammer. Joyce started out slowly with fouls on her first two throws and didn't win the event until a mark of 204-1 on her final throw. The Canadian and Cal record holder finished second in the hammer as a freshman and sophomore at Pac-10s and third as a junior. Joyce enters the NCAA Championships No. 2 in the hammer (214-0) and No. 7 in the discus (178-3). This is the fourth-straight year Joyce will be competing in the NCAA hammer competition. She earned All-America honors for her fourth-place showing in 2000.

**BELGER PURSUES 800M NATIONAL TITLE:** The daughter of national collegiate 800m champions, **Erin Belger** has had a lot of pressure to excel in track and field. For the first time, Belger has qualified for the 800m at NCAAs with the fifth-fastest time in the country (2:04.39), which is second all-time at Cal. Erin's mother, Sue (Vigil – maiden name), won the 800m title at the 1979 AIAW nationals for New Mexico with Cal coach Tony Sandoval as her coach. Her father, Mark, claimed the 1979 NCAA 800m title at Villanova.

**MCLEAN, VANEK LOOK TO REPEAT AS ALL-AMERICANS:** **Bubba McLean** and **Missy Vanek** are each competing in their second NCAA Championships and are looking to repeat as All-Americans. McLean, who earned All-America honors for his fifth-place finish in the pole vault last season, qualified for nationals this year by tying for the fifth-best mark in the nation (18-0.5). He is one of three Cal athletes to ever clear 18 feet in the pole vault. Vanek garnered All-America honors in the heptathlon in 2000 by placing third (PR: 5614). She has the sixth-best qualifying point total in 2002 at 5498. She was forced to pull out of the Pac-10 meet after injuring her hamstring during the high jump warm-up.

**RUSSELL, SCHLUETER, EARN FIRST NCAA SELECTIONS:** **Marielle Schlueter** and **Sheni Russell** are competing in their first ever NCAA Championships. Schlueter set the Cal record in the 3000mSC at 10:22.38, which was enough to qualify her for NCAAs with the 20th-best time. Russell qualified in the discus at No. 15 (174-7), which ranks her fifth all-time at Cal.

## California Athletes at the NCAA Championships

**Erin Belger**  
Senior, Albuquerque, NM      **800m**

Belger ranks fourth in the nation in the 800m with a time of 2:04.39, set in her victory at the Big Meet vs. Stanford...finished sixth in the 800m at the 2002 Pac-10 Championships...No. 2 on Cal's all-time 800m performers' chart...also owns the Bears' top 1500m time this year at 4:30.22.

Personal note: her parents were both 800m collegiate national champions...art major, with an interest in sculpting.

**Jennifer Joyce**  
Senior, Vancouver, B.C.      **Hammer-Discus**

Joyce set the Canadian national record in the hammer of 214-0 with her victory at the Big Meet...that mark also is the Cal and Big Meet record...competing in her fourth-straight NCAA hammer competition (1999: 15th, 2000: 4th, 2001: 10th)...earned All-America honors in 2000...won the 2002 Pac-10 hammer title after placing second as a freshman and sophomore and third as a junior...ranks second in the nation in the hammer and seventh in the discus (178-3) this year...No. 2 on Cal's all-time discus performers' chart...twice earned Pac-10 Women's Field Athlete of the Week this season and has a total of three for her career...selected to the second team Academic All-District VIII team.

Personal note: Hopes to compete for Canada in Athens in 2004...began her track and field career as a sprinter, hurdler and high jumper at age 12.

**Bubba McLean**  
Senior, Kula, Hawaii      **Pole Vault**

McLean became only the third pole vaulter in Cal history to clear at least 18 feet in the pole vault at the Big Meet...won the event with a clearance of 18-0.5...ranked No. 3 in school history in the pole vault behind only Brent Burns (18-8.25) and Clarence Phelps (18-5.25)...tied for No. 5 in the nation in the pole vault this season...finished eighth (17-3.5) in the pole vault at the 2002 Pac-10 Championships...selected to the second team Academic All-District VIII team.

Personal note: Spends his summers fishing for salmon in Alaska...has tales to tell about run-ins with grizzly bears while he smelled like salmon.

**Sheni Russell**  
Junior, Riverside, CA      **Discus**

After being slowed by an injury in 2001, Russell qualified for her first NCAA Championships with the 15th-best mark in the nation in the discus at 174-7 (PR)...threw that mark at the UC San Diego Open in May...ranks fifth all-time in Cal history in the discus...finished sixth in the discus at the 2002 Pac-10 Championships with a mark of 162-10...also threw PRs in the shot (47-5) and hammer (176-3) this year.

Personal note: Since graduating from high school, has improved on her high school PR in the discus by over 33 feet.

**Marielle Schlueter**  
Senior, San Francisco, CA      **3000mSC**

Schlueter set the school record in the 3000mSC (10:22.38) with her second-place finish at the 2002 Big Meet...rated No. 20 in the nation in the 3000mSC this year heading into her first NCAA Championships...has run the Bears' fastest 5000m time this season (18:08.45)...finished ninth in the steeplechase (11:21.61) at the 2002 Pac-10 Championships.

Personal note: Engaged to be married to Jon Ritchie of the Oakland Raiders.

**Missy Vanek**      **questionable -- hamstring**  
Senior, Laclede, ID      **Heptathlon**

Vanek finished second in the heptathlon at the 2002 Pac-10 Multi-Event Championships with a season-best 5498 points...rated No. 6 in the nation in the heptathlon heading into her second NCAAAs...has been banged up on and off this season with a hamstring and ankle injury and re-injured her hamstring at the Pac-10 meet...earned All-America honors for her third-place finish in the heptathlon in 2000 (PR: 5614)...ranked No. 2 in Cal history in the heptathlon...set a PR of 142-5 in the javelin with her Big Meet win this year...that mark ranks No. 7 on Cal's all-time performers' list...cleared a season best of 5-7.25 at the Pac-10 heptathlon competition...tied for No. 8 in Cal history in the high jump with a PR of 5-8.75...posted Cal's second-best long jump mark this year with a PR of 18-10.75 at the Cal/Nevada heptathlon.

Personal note: Is married to Paul Vanek...grew up in a town with a population of 213...likes to hunt.
