RADIO: KALX Radio (90.7 FM) will broadcast the Apr. 12-14 USC-Cal games...**SERIES RECORD:** Cal has a 126-209 overall series record against the USC Trojans...last season, the Bears won two-of-three games (lost 6-5, won 9-5, won 4-3) Apr. 14-16 in Berkeley...

HEAD COACH DAVID ESQUER: The Bears coach is in his second season at Cal and has a career record of 46-44 (.511)...Esquer, 35, became only the 10th coach in the long history of Cal baseball, which began in 1892, when he was hired June 10, 1999...Esquer replaced longtime Bear mentor Bob Milano, who retired May 17, 1999 after 22 years as the Bears head coach and 29 years involved in the Cal baseball program... Esquer came to Berkeley after serving as the top assistant at Pepperdine from 1996-99...prior to working at Pepperdine, he was the No. 2 assistant coach at Stanford under Mark Marquess from 1991-96...a shortstop at Stanford from 1984-87, Esquer was a starter on Stanford's 1987 College World Series championship team, earning All-Tournament honors after hitting .350 with six RBI in Omaha...he also earned All-Pac-10 Southern Division honors as a senior and went on to play professional baseball for four seasons with the Baltimore Orioles, California Angels and Milwaukee Brewers organizations...

BEAR NOTES: The 2001 Cal baseball team is 21-16 overall and 6-6 in the Pac-10 after winning one-of-three games Apr. 6-8 at Oregon State (lost 6-5, lost 10-1, won 12-1) and defeating San Jose State, 9-7, Tuesday night in San Jose...the Bears 12-1 win over the Beavers Apr. 8 was the fourth straight Sunday Cal has exploded offensively, as the Bears won 17-5 Mar. 18 versus Arizona State, 10-1 (scored 10 runs in the first inning on nine hits) Mar. 25 versus Washington State and 16-7 Apr. 1 at Washington...Cal has now outscored its conference opponents, 55-14, on Sundays...the Bears have still been involved in 14 one-run games this season, going 5-9 in those contests, including last weekend's 6-5 loss at OSU...several close games is an indication of Cal's pitching strength and ability to keep the Bears in games (3.60 team ERA, second in the Pac-10, opponents are batting .261 against) and the continued need for improved offensive production (.275 team batting average, ninth in the Pac-10)...Cal is arguably the youngest team in the conference, regularly starting four freshmen (Brian Horwitz at left field, Conor Jackson at third base, Jeff Dragicevich at shortstop and Spencer Wyman or Creighton Kahoalii at catcher)...The Bears closer, Matt Brown, is also a freshman...one player who has helped Cal's offensive production is junior college transfer Carson White ... White is currently on a six-game hitting streak from Apr. 1 (9-for-24, .375, 3-2B, 4-HR, 14 RBI) and went 3-for-4 with two doubles, a home run and four RBI Tuesday at SJS...he also had the game-winning homer in the bottom of the 10th Apr. 3 versus San Francisco and went 2-for-5 with two home runs and a career-high six RBI Apr. 1 at Washington...White leads the Bears in triples (3), home runs (7) and RBI (30)...senior right-hander David Cash continues to pick up wins, earning the victory in relief Apr. 8 at OSU (4.0 innings, two hits, no earned runs, no walks, three strikeouts)...Cash is 7-2 (second in the Pac-10) and now has a career record of 20-6 with five saves at Cal...
