RADIO:KALX Radio (90.7 FM) will broadcast the Apr. 12-14 Arizona-Cal series...**SERIES RECORD:** Cal has a 56-79 overall series record against the Arizona Wildcats...last season the Bears won two-of-three games Apr. 20-22 at Frank Sancet Field (W 11-9, W 19-13, L 12-11 in 10 innings)...

HEAD COACH DAVID ESQUER: The 2001 Pac-10 Coach of the Year, Esquer, 36, is in his third season at Cal and has a career record of 81-69 (.540)...he became only the 10th coach in the history of Cal baseball, which began in 1892, when he was hired June 10, 1999...Esquer replaced longtime Bear mentor Bob Milano, who retired May 17, 1999 after 22 years as the Bears head coach and 29 years involved in the Cal baseball program...Esquer came to Berkeley after serving as the top assistant at Pepperdine from 1996-99...prior to working at Pepperdine, he was the No. 2 assistant coach at Stanford under Mark Marquess from 1991-96...a shortstop at Stanford from 1984-87, Esquer was a starter on Stanford's 1987 College World Series championship team, earning All-Tournament honors after hitting .350 with six RBI in Omaha...he also earned All-Pac-10 Southern Division honors as a senior and went on to play professional baseball for four seasons with the Baltimore Orioles, California Angels and Milwaukee Brewers organizations...

BEAR NOTES: The California baseball team (22-16, 5-4 Pac-10) won two-ofthree Apr. 5-7 versus UCLA (W 5-3, L 19-2, W 10-6 in 15 innings) at Evans Diamond and lost 6-5 Tuesday at Saint Mary's...in Cal's 15-inning win Apr. 7 over UCLA, sophomore designated hitter **David Weiner** hit a grand slam with one out in the 15th to lead the Bears to their fifth dramatic late-inning victory this season at Evans Diamond...senior right-hander Trevor Hutchinson was named Pac-10 Pitcher of the Week after Cal's 5-3 win over the Bruins...in 10 starts, Hutchinson has not thrown less than 6.3 innings, has two complete games, is 7-3 with a 3.03 ERA and has 72 strikeouts in 77.3 innings pitched...he has 262 career strikeouts, third on Cal's all-time career list and is 14 strikeouts away from being the school's all-time strikeout leader...Hutchinson leads the Pac-10 in both strikeouts and innings pitched...sophomore right-hander Matt Brown is already tied for fourth on the Cal all-time saves list with 14 saves in less than two seasons...sophomore first baseman Conor Jackson is continuing his remarkable 2002 campaign, batting .404 with 10 doubles, two triples, 11 home runs, two grand slams and 45 RBI...this season Jackson has hit home runs in four consecutive games and in three consecutive games...in the current Pac-10 hitting statistics, he leads the league in batting average, total bases (106), hits (59) and on base percentage (.485)...Hutchinson, Jackson and freshman third baseman David Nicholson (.313, 4-HR, 11 RBI) were all recently mentioned in Baseball America's Midseason All-America Teams By Class...

ARIZONA: The Arizona Wildcats, coached by Andy Lopez (First year at Arizona, 22-14, .611), are 22-14 (3-6) on the year, last winning one-of-three Apr. 5-7 versus Stanford (L 5-4 in 18 innings, L 19-1, W 15-13)...top hitters for the Wildcats are senior infielder Brad Hassey (.329, 4 HR, 27 RBI), freshman catcher Richard Mercado (.310, 1 HR, 19 RBI) and senior infielder Justyn St. Clair (.309, 1 HR, 22 RBI)...Arizona's tentative pitching rotation is sophomore right-hander Sean Rierson (5-2, 3.93 ERA), sophomore right-hander Marc Kaiser (5-2, 3.95 ERA) and sophomore left-hander Joe Little (5-3, 5.43 ERA)...last season the Bruins were 33-23, 12-12 (fifth) in the Pac-10...
