TELEVISION/RADIO: The Apr. 16 Cal-Stanford game will be shown tape delayed (Apr. 18 at 10:30 a.m., Apr. 19 at 12 p.m.) on Fox Sports Net, with Roxy Bernstein (play-by-play) and former Arizona baseball coach Jerry Kindall (color) announcing. KALX Radio (90.7 FM) will air the Apr. 16-18 Cal-Stanford series.

BEAR NOTES: The California baseball team (20-20, 6-6) faces a big challenge as it tries to snap a 13-game losing streak to No. 2 Stanford (26-5, 4-2) this week at Sunken Diamond. The last time Cal defeated the Cardinal was Mar. 9, 2002 (2-1) at Evans Diamond. The Bears were swept by Stanford (12-9, 10-3, 6-2) earlier this season in a non-conference series in Berkeley, Feb. 27-29. In league play this year, Cal has played better on the road, going 4-2 in series at ASU and USC, while going 2-4 in home series versus OSU and Washington. The Bears feature sophomore Adam Gold, who was one out away from a no-hitter at Fresno State Feb. 21 and was the Feb. 23 NCBWA National Co-Pitcher of the Week. Gold is on the watch list for the Roger Clemens Award as the nation's top pitcher and is currently 6-3, second in the Pac-10 in innings pitched (68.7) and third in strikeouts (69). Junior infielder David Nicholson and senior center fielder David Weiner (.343) are among Cal's top offensive performers. Nicholson is batting .399 and leads the Pac-10 in hits (59), while Weiner is leading the Bears in home runs (seven) and RBI (33). Junior left fielder Justin Nelson and junior DH James Holder are also hitting well. Nelson had a two-run triple and two-run homer Tuesday versus San Jose State, and Holder has homered in each of the last three games. The Bears' top reliever is junior Jesse Ingram, who leads the Pac-10 in appearances (20), saves (seven) and ERA (2.31).

SERIES RECORD: Cal has a 207-226 overall series record against the Stanford Cardinal. In the last meeting, the Bears were swept (12-9, 10-3, 6-2) in a nonconference series at Evans Diamond Feb. 27-29.

HEAD COACH DAVID ESQUER: The 2001 Pac-10 Coach of the Year, Esquer, 38, is in his fifth season at Cal with a career record of 136-127 (.517). On June 10, 1999, he became only the 10th coach in the history of Cal baseball, which began in 1892. Esquer replaced longtime coach Bob Milano, who retired May 17, 1999 after 22 years as the Bears' head coach and 29 years involved in the Cal baseball program. Esquer came to Berkeley after serving as the top assistant at Pepperdine from 1996-99. He was the No. 2 assistant coach at Stanford under Mark Marquess from 1991-96. A shortstop at Stanford from 1984-87, Esquer was a starter on the 1987 College World Series championship team, earning All-Tournament honors after hitting .350 with six RBI. He also earned All-Pac-10 Southern Division honors and went on to play professional baseball for four seasons with the Baltimore, California and Milwaukee organizations.

STANFORD: The Stanford Cardinal, coached by Mark Marquess (28th year, 1,170-556-5, .676), are 26-5, 4-2 after winning two-of-three last weekend at Oregon State (W 11-8, L 5-4, W 16-4) winning Tuesday versus Santa Clara (12-3). Top hitters for the Cardinal are sophomore second baseman Jed Lowrie (.388, 10 HR, 43 RBI), senior third baseman Jonny Ash (.383, 4 HR, 25 RBI) and sophomore first baseman John Mayberry, Jr. (.369, 9 HR, 38 RBI). Stanford's tentative pitching rotation is sophomore left-hander Mark Romanczuk (6-1, 4.04 ERA), TBA and TBA. In 2003, the Cardinal finished 51-18 overall, 18-6 in the Pac-10 (first), 10-3 in the postseason – placing second at the College World Series.

2004 CAL OUTLOOK: The 2004 Golden Bears are led by seniors **Matt Brown** (right-handed pitcher), **Brian Horwitz** (right field) and **Jeff Dragicevich** (shortstop) – all four-year starters and members of Cal's 2001 NCAA Regional Squad. The Bears also return senior catcher **Chris Grossman**, a 2003 semifinalist for the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. Cal is predicted to be a NCAA Regional team by *Baseball America* and is selected to finish sixth in the Pac-10 Coaches Preseason Poll. Cal will be attempting to qualify for NCAA postseason for the 10th time in school history and the second time in David Esquer's five-year head coaching tenure with the Bears. Cal was ranked 26th in *Baseball America*'s Preseason Top-50 Poll and features a freshman class that is rated the nation's fifth-best in *Baseball America*.

CAL PLAYERS TO WATCH: Brian Horwitz, right field, SR – 2003 Pac-10 Honorable Mention, hit .347 with team-high 47 RBI; school record holder for consecutive game hitting streak (23) and single-game RBI (eight)...Chris Grossman, catcher, SR – 2003 Pac-10 Honorable Mention, hit .341 with team-high hits (72), doubles (16) and total bases (112); 2003 semifinalist for the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top catcher; on 2004 Johnny Bench Award Watch List...Jeff Dragicevich, shortstop, SR – 2003 Pac-10 Honorable Mention, hit .292 with a .326 Pac-10 average; three-year starter with career .300 Pac-10 batting average...Matt Brown, right-handed pitcher, SR – two-time Pac-10 Honorable Mention, led the Bears in strikeouts (66) and innings pitched (86.7) in 2003; 2002 Cape Cod League All-Star; third on the Cal all-time save list (16)...Jesse Ingram, right-handed pitcher, JR – in 2003 was 2-3 with eight saves, and had 49 strikeouts in 50.7 innings; was Apr. 8, 2003 Pac-10 Pitcher of the Week; eight saves in 2003 was second on Cal's single-season save list; third on the Cal all-time save list (16)...Mike Padgett, right-handed pitcher, JR – was 5-3 with a 3.43 ERA in 2003; limited opponents to .244 batting average; picked up Pac-10 wins over USC, Washington and Arizona...Adam Gold, right-handed pitcher, SO – in 2004, is 6-3 with a 3.28 ERA and second in the Pac-10 in innings pitched (68.7) and third in strikeouts (69); was one-out away from no-hitter Feb. 21 at Fresno State; was Feb. 23 NCBWA National Co-Pitcher of the Week; is on Roger Clemens Award Watch List as the nation's top collegiate pitcher.

KEY NEWCOMERS: Brennan Boesch, outfield/first base, FR – Harvard-Westlake HS (Los Angeles, CA) – 2003 All-CIF Southern Section; 2003 All-Los Angeles Times; 2003 Pacific Palisades Post Athlete of the Year; batted .490 with seven home runs... Garrett Bussiere, catcher, FR – Northglenn HS (Thornton, CO) – drafted in 14th round by the Milwaukee Brewers; 2003 first team All-State; batted .471 with six home runs and 26 RBI; Junior Olympic Team member in 2001 and 2002... Chris Errecart, outfield, FR – Lincoln HS (Stockton, CA) – 2003 first team all-league, all-area MVP, all-state and Collegiate Baseball All-American; batted .531 with 12 home runs, 41 RBI and 20 stolen bases... Brandon Morrow, right-handed pitcher, FR – Rancho Cotate HS (Rohnert Park, CA) – 2003 first team all-league and first team All-North Coast Section; was 9-2 with a 0.61 ERA and had 84 strikeouts in 63.0 innings as a senior; drafted in the 40th round by the Anaheim Angles.

2003 REVIEW: Cal did not qualify for a NCAA Regional in 2003 with an 28-27 overall record (10-14, seventh in the Pac-10), but had junior first baseman/third baseman Conor Jackson earn first team All-Pac-10 honors and three players — Brian Horwitz, Chris Grossman and Jeff Dragicevich — named Pac-10 Honorable Mention. Jackson was the Arizona Diamondbacks' first round draft pick and the 19th pick overall in the 2003 June Major League Amateur Draft. Last spring, he batted .388 with 14 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 44 RBI and a Pac-10-leading .538 on-base percentage. Jackson was selected a third team All-American by Baseball America and earned All-Pac-10 honors for the second year. He was the first Cal baseball player to be drafted in the first round since right-handed pitcher Dave Masters was selected by the Chicago Cubs and was the 24th pick overall in 1985. Besides Jackson, junior right-hander Brian Montalbo was picked in the seventh round by the Milwaukee Brewers, Horwitz was selected in the 26th round by the Oakland A's, and Brown was picked in the 29th round by the Chicago Cubs.
