**RADIO:** KALX Radio (90.7 FM) will broadcast the Apr. 27-29 Stanford-Cal games...**SERIES RECORD:** Cal has a 204-211 overall series record against the Stanford Cardinal...earlier this season in a non-conference match-up, the Bears won one-of-three games (lost 3-1 Mar. 2, won 3-2 Mar. 3, lost 3-2 in 10 innings) Mar. 2-7 at Stanford...

**HEAD COACH DAVID ESQUER:** The Bears coach is in his second season at Cal and has a career record of 49-49 (.500)...Esquer, 35, became only the 10th coach in the long history of Cal baseball, which began in 1892, when he was hired June 10, 1999...Esquer replaced longtime Bear mentor Bob Milano, who retired May 17, 1999 after 22 years as the Bears head coach and 29 years involved in the Cal baseball program... Esquer came to Berkeley after serving as the top assistant at Pepperdine from 1996-99...prior to working at Pepperdine, he was the No. 2 assistant coach at Stanford under Mark Marquess from 1991-96...a shortstop at Stanford from 1984-87, Esquer, along with assistant **Ron Witmeyer**, were starters on Stanford's 1987 College World Series championship team, earning All-Tournament honors after hitting .350 with six RBI in Omaha...he also earned All-Pac-10 Southern Division honors as a senior and went on to play professional baseball for four seasons with the Baltimore Orioles, California Angels and Milwaukee Brewers organizations...

**BEAR NOTES:** The Cal baseball team, 24-21 overall and 9-9 in the Pac-10 has a huge series against Bay Area rival Stanford Apr. 27-29 at Evans Diamond...earlier this season, the Bears won one-of-three non-conference games at Sunken Diamond, losing 3-1 Mar. 2, winning 3-2 Mar. 3 and losing 3-2 in 10 innings Mar. 4...the young Bears, who regularly start three freshmen and three sophomores, are fresh off of winning two-of-three games at Arizona Apr. 20-22...Cal won the first two games of the series against the Wildcats, 11-9 and 19-13, before falling, 12-11 in 10 innings in the series final...over the weekend in Tucson, the Bears offense came alive, scoring 41 runs on 53 hits...improve offensive production should be a key for Cal, as all season long the Bears have been strong on the mound, sporting a respectable 4.11 team ERA, but after the weekend at Arizona, have raised their team batting average to .284...Cal is currently tied for fourth place with UCLA (6-6) in the Pac-10 behind Stanford (11-4), USC (10-5) and Oregon State (8-7)...senior **Rob Meyer** currently leads Cal with a .338 batting average after going 7-for-15 with two doubles, a home run and four RBI at Arizona and 2-for-4 with two doubles Tuesday at Nevada...junior college transfer **Carson White** was also hot against the Wildcats and the Wolf Pack, going 6-for-14 with two doubles, a triple and six RBI at Arizona and 2-for-4 with a home run at Nevada...White is on a 14-game hitting streak, batting .327 overall and leading the Bears in triples (four), home runs (eight) and RBI (38)...other top hitters for Cal include sophomore catcher **John Baker** (.325) and freshman shortstop **Jeff Dragicevich** (.320)...Dragicevich's older brother, Scott, is the starting shortstop for Stanford...Cal's No. 1 starter, junior right-hander **Trevor Hutchinson**, also has a Stanford connection as he is the younger brother of former Cardinal two-sport standout, Chad Hutchinson... the Bears senior first baseman **Clint Hoover** is moving up in the Cal career list as he hit his fourth career grand slam last weekend and is now fifth on the career list for home runs (34) and 10th for career RBI (137)...on the mound, senior **David Cash** is currently 8-2 with a 3.42 ERA and leads the team with 75 strikeouts in 68.3 innings...Cash has a career mark of 21-6 with five saves as a Bear, good for fifth on the Cal all-time win list...freshman closer **Matt Brown** leads the Pac-10 with seven saves...

**STANFORD:** The Stanford Cardinal (No. 3 in *Baseball America*), coached by Mark Marquess (25th year, 1028-508-5, .669), are 33-10, 11-4 in the Pac-10...top hitters for the Cardinal are freshman center fielder Sam Fuld (.347, 0 HR, 19 RBI), sophomore catcher Ryan Garko (.343, 3 HR, 20 RBI) and freshman right fielder Carlos Quentin (.336, 7 HR, 32 RBI)...Stanford's tentative pitching rotation is sophomore right-hander Jeremy Guthrie (8-2, 1.69 ERA), junior right-hander Jeff Bruksch (8-1, 2.76 ERA) and junior left-hander Mike Gosling (4-0, 3.44 ERA)...last season, the Cardinal finished 50-16 overall (17-7, 1st tie in Pac-10) and finished second in the College World Series...
