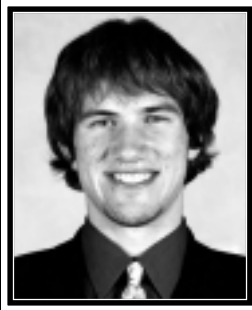

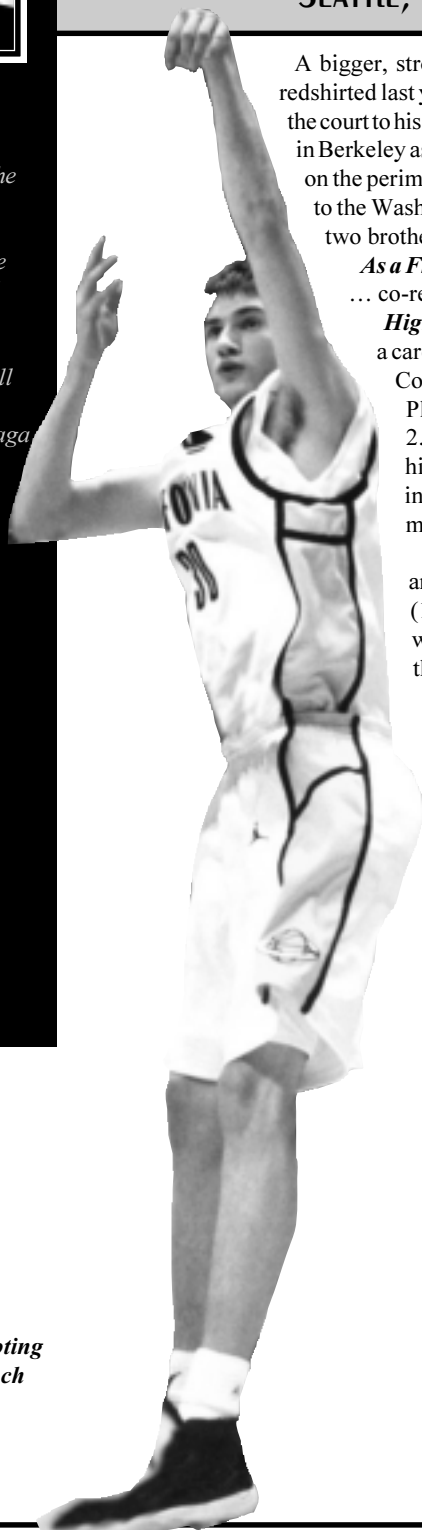

A bigger, stronger Erik Bond returns for his second attempt at his freshman season ... redshirted last year after undergoing surgery on his right ankle ... used his season away from the court to his benefit, especially in the weight room where he gained 15 pounds since arriving in Berkeley as a 190-pound rookie ... a fluid wing player who gives the Bears a tall presence on the perimeter ... brings a winning background to Cal after leading his high school team to the Washington state title as a junior ... comes from an athletic family as his father and two brothers played basketball at the college level ... has a 37-inch vertical leap.

As a Freshman in 2001-02: Bond redshirted after undergoing ankle surgery Nov. 10 ... co-recipient of Cal's Best Academic Performance award.

High School: Bond averaged 20 ppg and 9 rpg as a senior at Seattle Prep ... scored a career high of 36 points in one game ... rated the No. 3 small forward on the West Coast by Rivals.com ... a two-time first team all-state performer ... earned state Player of the Year honors as a junior when he averaged 20.8 ppg, 7.5 rpg and 2.5 apg ... also named MVP of the 3A state playoffs that season after leading his team to the championship ... averaged 22.5 ppg in the state tournament ... in track & field, set a school record and placed second in the state meet with a mark of 6-8 in the high jump his senior year ... cleared 6-10 in practice.

Personal: Erik Jay Bond ... born Dec. 15, 1982 in Seattle, WA ... parents are Jay and Loui Bond ... father, who is 6-10, played basketball at Washington (1968-70) ... in addition, brother, Jason, played at Gonzaga and brother, Jesse, was on the basketball team at Saint Mary's ... lists surfing as one of his off-the-court hobbies ... undeclared major.

One of the quickest guards in the Pac-10, if not the country, Diggs brings the experience of two full collegiate seasons to the point guard position ... rewarded with a scholarship during the offseason after arriving at Cal as a walk-on from Long Beach Poly HS ... plays with a high level of energy and enthusiasm ... led the Bears and ranked 10th in the Pac-10 with 47 steals last year despite playing just over 16 minutes per game ... voted the preseason Pac-10 Defensive Player of the Year by *Athlon* magazine for his ability to disrupt opposing offenses ... spent much of the summer working to improve his offensive game ... turned down scholarship opportunities at several smaller schools to walk-on at Cal.

As a Sophomore in 2001-02: Averaged 3.2 points, 1.6 assists and 1.5 steals during the season ... saw action in all 32 games, including six starts ... swiped a Golden Bear Classic record six steals in only 11 minutes vs. Harvard Dec. 28 ... also picked off three steals in both games against Oregon State ... earned the first of five consecutive starts at OSU Jan. 12, finishing with four points and three rebounds, in addition to the three steals



... had four steals in 17 minutes vs. UCLA at home ... tied a career high with four assists against Santa Clara and matched that total vs. Mount St. Mary's and in a double OT win over Oregon ... scored 12 points against Washington State Jan. 19 and followed that up with eight points in a victory at USC Jan. 24 ... played one of his best games vs. Stanford in Berkeley, ending with five points and five rebounds ... started in place of an injured Shantay Legans against USC Feb. 23 and responded with the most impressive performance of his career – 12 points, 4 assists and 3 steals – in leading the Bears to an 83-64 victory ... had four assists, no turnovers and three steals vs. Penn in the first round of the NCAA Tournament ... co-recipient of Cal's Best Defensive Player award.

As a Freshman in 2000-01: Did not play in the first two games of the year, then gained his initial playing time at Saint Louis Nov. 29 ... played well in his next outing at UC Irvine when he scored three points and grabbed five rebounds in 13 minutes ... had a strong game vs. Albany Dec. 11 with two points, two steals, three assists and six rebounds ... played a season-high 15 minutes against Yale in the first round of the Golden Bear Classic ... helped spark Cal's win at Washington Jan. 27 with four points in 11 minutes ... tallied a best of five points to go with three steals vs. USC Feb. 3 ... figured heavily in road wins over Oregon State and Oregon the next week, grabbing three steals at OSU and scored two points with an assist and a steal and no turnovers in 12 minutes against the Ducks ... played at least nine minutes in six of Cal's last nine regular-season games, including 14 minutes at Oregon State and vs. Stanford.

High School: Diggs was a three-time all-league performer at Long Beach Poly HS ... averaged 11 ppg, 5 apg, 4 spg as a senior ... led his team to the 2000 CIF title ... as a junior, named All-CIF after averaging 16 ppg, 8 apg and 6 spg ... Long Beach Poly set a school record for victories that season with a 29-3 mark ... voted his team's Defensive MVP in both 1999 and 2000 ... member of the Principal's Honor Roll.

Personal: Austin Joseph Diggs ... born June 17, 1982 in Long Beach, CA ... mother is Sharon Jackson and father is Shelton Diggs ... father played wide receiver at USC (1973-76) and for the New York Jets (1977) ... sociology major.

Junior A.J. Diggs is one of the quickest players in the Pac-10 Conference.

Famulener figures to become more of a factor for the Bears this year after learning the ropes his first two seasons in the program ... a hard-working forward who is not afraid of physical play ... earned a scholarship for the 2002-03 season after arriving as a walk-on ... despite his limited playing time so far, returns as one of Cal's most experienced frontcourt performers ... attended the Pete Newell Big Man Camp in August 2002 ... brings a positive attitude and winning background to the team after helping nearby De La Salle HS to the 2000 California state championship ... has the ability to score from three-point range.

As a Sophomore in 2001-02: Greatly increased his contributions from his freshman season by appearing in 21 games during the year, up from 10 as a rookie ... didn't see much action early in the year, but then played 12 minutes and finished with two points, two rebounds and four assists vs. Fresno State ... with Solomon Hughes sidelined with a knee injury, played 13 minutes (2 points) in a win over Stanford and had four points in seven minutes at Oregon ... also got in for 13 minutes vs. Washington State and had three points and three boards ... one of his most productive games came against the Cougars in Pullman, finishing with four points and five rebounds.

As a Freshman in 2000-01: Saw limited action during the season, appearing in 10 games for the Bears ... scored his first point of the year and also grabbed a pair of rebounds vs. Albany Dec. 11 ... tallied five points in the closing minute of Cal's win over Washington State Feb. 24, making both of his shots from the floor, including a three-pointer.

High School: Famulener helped De La Salle HS to a 31-1 overall record and a No. 3 national ranking by *USA Today* ... averaged 6.2 ppg and a team-leading 6.4 rpg while shooting 50.7 percent from the floor and 39 percent from three-point range ... earned honorable mention all-league ... voted his team's Most Improved Player ... during his junior season, helped De La Salle to a league title and to a runner-up finish in northern California ... also played tennis for two seasons.

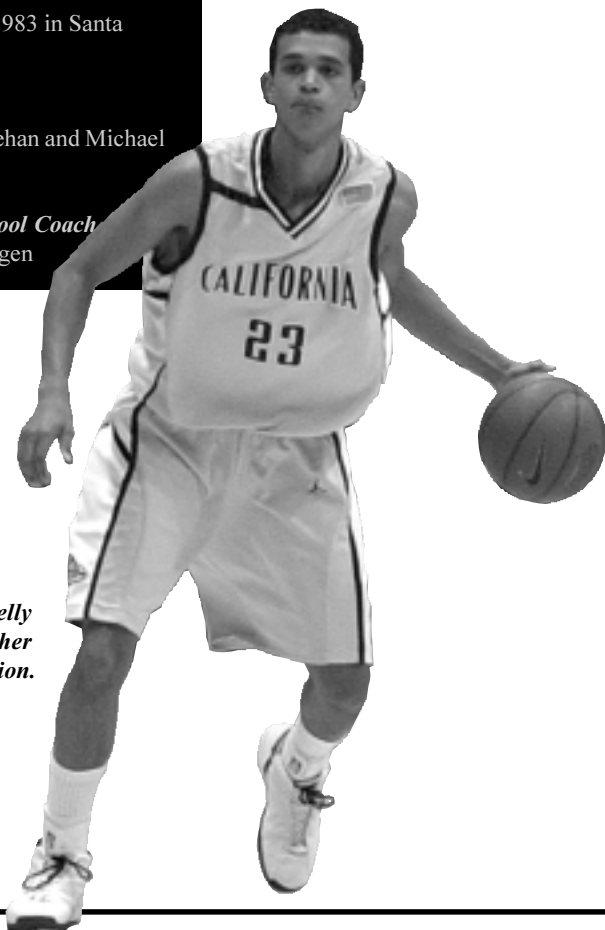

Hughes is an athletic big man who runs the floor well and has good shot-blocking and rebounding skills ... after playing in a reserve role his first two seasons, returns as one of Cal's most experienced post players ... has gained 15 pounds since arriving on campus in the fall of 2000 ... younger brother of former Bear center Solomon Hughes (1999-2002) ... brings a lot of spirit and enthusiasm to the court ... an extremely accurate shooter from the floor who made 70.4 percent of his attempts last season and has connected on 61.1 percent for his career.

As a Sophomore in 2001-02: Playing time nearly doubled from his freshman season ... ranked fourth on the team with 10 blocked shots ... in 11 minutes vs. Fresno State Dec. 11, finished with three points, four rebounds and a career-best three blocks ... also had nine points in nine minutes vs. Mount St. Mary's ... saw his most extensive action at Washington State Feb. 13 when he finished with career highs in points (10) and rebounds (6) in 14 minutes.

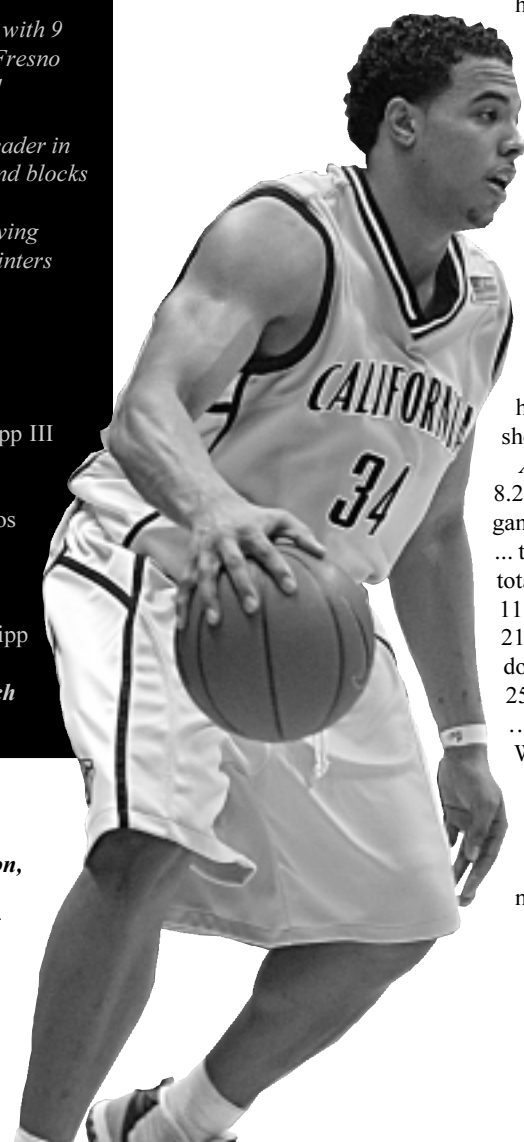
