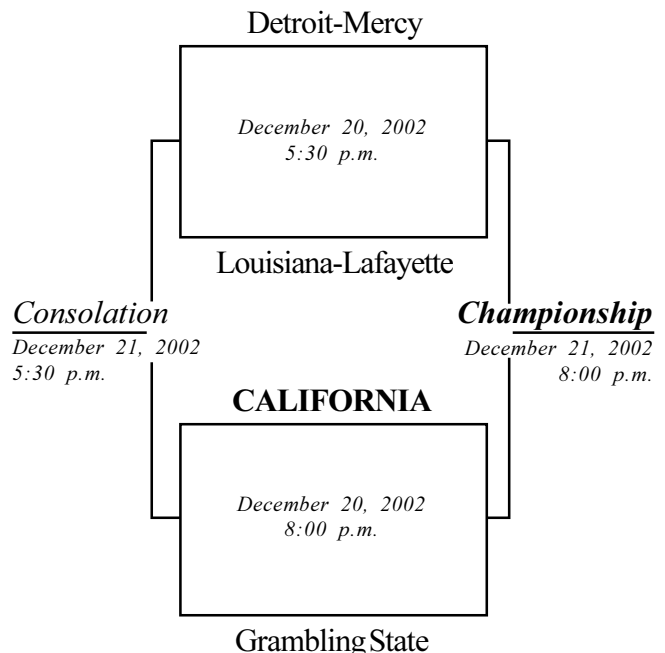

PETE NEWELL CHALLENGE

On Dec. 28, 2002, the Oakland Arena will host the sixth annual Pete Newell Challenge. The doubleheader pits Cal against Kansas in the opener at 12:30 p.m., followed by Stanford vs. Gonzaga. ABC will televise the Cal-Kansas game.

In just five years, the Pete Newell Challenge has become one of the premier events in college basketball. Kansas and Gonzaga join an impressive list of Pete Newell Challenge past participants that includes such top national programs as Duke, North Carolina, Michigan State, Michigan, Indiana, Georgia, Mississippi State and Brigham Young.

All four teams that are partaking in this year's event advanced to the NCAA Tournament last season with Kansas reaching the Final Four and Cal and Stanford going to the second round.

Cal and Stanford are both 4-0 in Pete Newell Challenge competition. The Bears have knocked off BYU, North Carolina, Georgia and Gonzaga, while the Cardinal has defeated Temple, Duke, Mississippi State and Michigan State.

The Pete Newell Challenge was created to honor the Hall of Fame legend who won a coaching version of the Triple Crown – an NIT championship at San Francisco (1949), an NCAA title at Cal (1959) and an Olympic gold medal for the United States (Rome, 1960).

Newell, who turned 87 last Aug. 31, continues to teach both college and professional players – men and women – through clinics and seminars around the world, and at his annual Pete Newell Big Man Camp in Honolulu. This past summer marked the 25th anniversary of the highly regarded camp.
