

# 2003 PLAYER PROFILES



Has blossomed into one of the conference's better defensive interior linemen, earning All-Pac-10 honorable mention notice as a sophomore last season ... has earned a reputation for stuffing the run and providing internal pressure on the interior line ... one of the nation's premier recruits two years ago ... a massive player with all the tools to develop into a college All-American ... has a great combination of size, strength and instincts ... runs a 4.8 in 40-yard dash ... "We have high expectations for Lorenzo this year," said defensive line coach Ken Delgado. "He should be one of our leaders among a group of tackles that will set the tone for our entire defensive unit." ... 2002 ... posted 25 tackles (19 solo), five tackles for losses, one sack and one fumble recovery in winning the Bob Tessier Award as the team's Most Improved Lineman on defense ... also blocked two kicks for the Bears on special teams ... played in all 12 games, drawing six starts (Game 1 and Games 8-12) ... paramount effort came in Cal's 17-12 win over UCLA Oct. 19 when he bagged four tackles, including two stops for losses of six yards, and recovered a critical fumble ... also nabbed four tackles in the season opener vs. Baylor and tallied his lone sack of the season in the Big Game against Stanford ... 2001 ... baptized under fire, receiving estimable playing time in all 11 games during his rookie year as a true freshman... pocketed 24 tackles (including five for losses of 15 yards), one sack and one fumble recovery in earning 2001 Pac-10 All-Freshmen first team honors from The Sporting News ... started last five games at defensive tackle, a period in which he notched 16 tackles ... punched out season-high six tackles in the Big Game at Stanford ... despite not posting a single tackle, credited with a fumble recovery, a blocked extra-point and a pass defensed against eventual Pac-10 champion Oregon Oct. 13 ... recorded a seven-yard sack at UCLA ... named Cal's most intense freshman at the end of the year (Clint Evans Award).

High School/Personal: Earned SuperPrep All-America honors, ranking as the No. 7 defensive line recruit in the country ... also rated No. 44 prospect in the nation by SuperPrep and ranked No. 5 among all recruits in Far West ... ranked as the No. 2 defensive line prospect in the West by PrepStar, earning Dream Team Status and rating as the No. 10 defensive line prospect in the country by that publication... received 7 votes on Long Beach Press-Telegram's Best in the West list ... picked to play on California state all-star team vs. Florida ... finished his senior season with 120 tackles, including 17 sacks among 25 tackles behind the line of scrimmage ... also caused five fumbles and recovered three others ... mother is Stephanie Moore ... born May 31, 1983.




A good all-around athlete who has only been playing organized football for four years ... quick learner who is intelligent on and off the field ... performed well in early spring camp before a high ankle sprain sidelined him for the remainder of camp ... joined the Bears as a walk-on in the fall of 2001 ... 2002 ... after not playing in Cal's four non-conference games, was utilized on special teams in all eight Pac-10 contests ... failed to register a tackle, however ... 2001 ... came to Cal and redshirted.

High School/Personal: Only began playing football at Aquinas HS during his junior year ... during that season, named second team all-league ... started both ways as a senior ... on offense, averaged 6.4 yards per carry and 12 yards per catch ... on defense, had 65 tackles, four sacks, and five interceptions ... named first team All-CIF and first team all-league, and his team won the CIF championship ... also lettered three years in basketball and track ... named Student-Athlete of the Year as a senior ... aspires to attend medical school and become a doctor ... parents are Vincent and Gina Amajoyi ... born Dec. 26, 1983 in Austin, TX.



Transferred to Cal after two stellar seasons in the JC ranks at College of the Canyons in Santa Clarita ... expected to challenge for playing time at tailback this fall

Junior College/High School/Personal: Listed as the 46th best junior college player in the country by SuperPrep magazine ... named to the 2002 All-Region 3 Team by the California Community College Football Coaches Association and JC Athletic Bureau ... rushed for 769 yards and 19 touchdowns in only 135 carries last season, while also catching 30 passes for 320 yards and four additional TDs ... his 19 rushing TDs in 2002 and 29 career rushing scores during his two-year stint at Canyons were both school records ... also set or tied school marks for touchdowns in a game (5 twice) and season (23), and points in a game (30, twice), season (138) and career (198) ... averaged 5.7 yards per carry last year despite playing behind an undersized line at College of the Canyons, a school that ranked among the Top 3 JuCos in Southern California and posted a final 10-2 record en route to the California State Championship Bowl (losing to Reedley, 35-15) ... timed in 4.5 seconds in the 40-yard dash ... originally from Rocky Mount, N.C., where he played at Northern Nash High School ... born Jan. 23, 1983.




A high intensity player who has started 25 games during his first three seasons in Berkeley ... following minor shoulder surgery during off-season, he's expected to return to full strength this year to provide critical senior leadership and stability to Bears' defense ... a coach's son who has a good understanding of the game ... has also served as Cal's short snapper on field goal and extra point attempts the past two years ... 2002 ... as a part-time starter at tackle, he piled up 18 tackles (11 solo), 4.5 tackles for losses of 21 yards and forced one fumble ... swarmed inside for three sacks, tied for fifth on the team ... played in all 12 contests, starting in six of them (Games 2-7) ... top tackle games came on the road at Michigan State and USC, garnering four stops in both tilts ... produced one sack in both the Washington and Stanford games ... also forced a fumble, broke up a pass and recorded two tackles in the 34-13 victory over New Mexico State ... 2001 ... 13 of his 27 tackles occurred in final three games of campaign, including a sterling effort against USC Nov. 10 when he bagged a team-high eight tackles and forced a fumble ... also managed three stops and one sack at Rutgers in the season finale ... early in the season, recorded two tackles for loss vs. BYU ... 2000 ... played in all 11 games for the Bears and moved into the lineup after season opener to start last 10 games as redshirt-freshman ... finished with at least three tackles seven times, including a high of five tackles (4 unassisted) at Arizona State ... had five tackles for loss and a pair of sacks on the year ... 1999 ... redshirted while rehabilitating a back injury in 1999.

High School/Personal: A four-year varsity starting linebacker (39 games) as a prep ... earned first team San Bernardino County honors and Defensive MVP of the Skyline League as both a junior and senior ... finished his senior year with 183 tackles ... earned first team all-state honors (small schools division) in 1998 ... a second team Southern Section All-CIF selection ... also played OL and was credited with 49 pancake blocks his senior year ... had 158 tackles as a junior ... a standout prep baseball catcher, batting .427 as a junior and earning all-league honors ... American studies major ... father, Mark, played football at Cal Lutheran and is the head coach at Oxnard HS ... mother, Kathleen, is a teacher at Oxnard HS ... lists Levon Kirkland as his favorite pro player ... born Oct. 10, 1980 in Houston, TX.



High School/Personal: Named All-West Region by PrepStar magazine ... as senior at Palisades High, corralled 20 passes for 300 yards and four touchdowns ... also earned All-Western Conference first team honors and was invited to play in the California Bowl in 2001 ... as junior, selected on SuperPrep magazine's All-West Region team and earned All-Western Conference first team honors after hauling in 25 passes for 621 yards and nine touchdowns ... rated 11th-best tight end on West Coast by PacWestFootball.com ... one of 18 local scholar-athletes to be honored by L.A. chapter of National Football Foundation and Hall of Fame ... also played varsity baseball for three years at Paly High, including two seasons as team captain ... parents are Norm and Harriet Beegun, both attorneys and UCLA graduates ... born Nov. 30, 1983 in Santa Monica, CA.



Continued to be a significant contributor to Cal's coverage game as a parttime starter at cornerback last season ... a physical player who is a big hitter ... as the lone senior in this year's secondary, expected to provide vital leadership ... projected to start at cornerback ... has started 15 games during the past two seasons ... a solid special teams player who has returned 29 kickoffs for 581 yards (20.0 avg.) the past three years ... 2002 ... tied for sixth in the Pac-10 with four interceptions (0.33 per game), including a brilliant two-pick effort in Cal's 46-22 upset at Michigan State Sept. 14 ... only Washington State's Will Derting had more interceptions (three) in a game among Pac-10 players last season ... was second to Jemeel Powell (five) on the team in interceptions ... returned his four picks a total of 48 yards ... also tied for seventh on '02 club in tackles with 42, including 35 solo stops ... played in all 12 games, starting in seven ... perhaps the crowning moment of his season came against Arizona Nov. 16 when he scooped up a blocked field goal attempt and raced 60 yards for a touchdown ... his best overall performance occurred at Michigan State, with his two interceptions and a season-high seven tackles, plus two passes broken up ... his other interceptions came at home against Baylor (returned 32 yards) and UCLA (13 yards) ... enjoyed his finest season as a kick returner, averaging 22.9 yards per return (9 for 206) as backup to Pac-10 leader, LaShaun Ward (28.9) ... returned four kicks for 105 yards in the Baylor opener, including a season-high 49-yarder ... 2001 ... finished the season with 39 total tackles, including 30 unassisted stops ... started eight games at the corner ... did not record an interception, but did break up five passes ... came through with eight tackles vs. both USC and Oregon ... also had four stops in the finale at Rutgers ... returned three kickoffs for 56 yards, including a 27-yarder, in the opener vs. Illinois ... 2000 ... finished the season with 14 total tackles ... recovered a fumbled punt return vs. Washington State to set up a first quarter Cal touchdown ... had a season-best four tackles (3 unassisted) at Arizona State ... averaged 18.8 yards on 17 kickoff returns ... first return of his career was a 50-yarder on the opening kickoff at Fresno State ... also had 26-yard returns at Arizona State and vs. Oregon State.

High School/Personal: Made his mark as a prep at running back, but moved to cornerback at Cal ... rushed for 1,982 yards (9.8 ypc average) as a senior ... best game was a 30-carry, 282-yard performance to key his prep team's first win over Taft HS in 20 years ... earned all-league and all-city honors ... the League Player of the Year, sharing the honor with two other players ... picked as a PrepStar All-American, rating as the No. 12 running back prospect in the West ... timed in 48.3 seconds in the 400 meters as a junior ... a National Football Foundation Scholar-Athlete as a prep ... has an interest in majoring in computer science at Cal ... selected honorable mention Pac-10 All-Academic in '01 ... father, James W. (computer programmer), played football at Hawaii ... mother is Gracie Bethea ... born Sept. 24, 1982 in Honolulu, HI.



An athletic linebacker who adds toughness to the defense ... has good size, along with outstanding speed and quickness.



SAC last year ... also ranked among PrepStar's Top 125 junior college players nationally ... a three-time first team all-league selection at Bishop Amat HS prior to his stint in JC ... reeled off 98 tackles (63 solo) and seven sacks at linebacker, while also scoring nine touchdowns at running back during his senior year ... rushed for 1,322 yards and 13 touchdowns on 163 carries during his three prep seasons ... clocked at 4.5 in the 40-yard dash ... born June 21, 1982.





High School/Personal: Voted MVP Lineman (both defense and offense) for De La Salle's 2001 national title team, also earning first team All-Bay Valley Athletic League and first team All-Bay Area Prep Team at defensive end ... racked up 75 tackles and 7.5 sacks (second on team) his senior season and also started at guard as two-way player ... after scoring 17 touchdowns in seven games at running back as a freshman, was voted team's MVP on offense at East Valley High in Spokane, WA ... transferred to De La Salle the next season, earning defensive MVP honors at nose tackle as sophomore ... as junior defensive end, gained first team All-BVAL and second team All-North Coast Section on De La Salle's national title club ... his test results at Nike Performance Camp in spring 2001 ranked fourth nationally, while his bench press (39 reps of 185 pounds) rated third-best in country ... named first team All-West linebacker and West Coast's 13th-best athlete by PacWest.com ... named one of Top 100 national prospects and All-Bay Area Football Team by SchoolSports.com, and also named one of Top 15 Bay Area football recruits by Contra Costa Times ... wrote PacWest.com before his senior season: "Briner looks to be the next great linebacker out of De La Salle.
