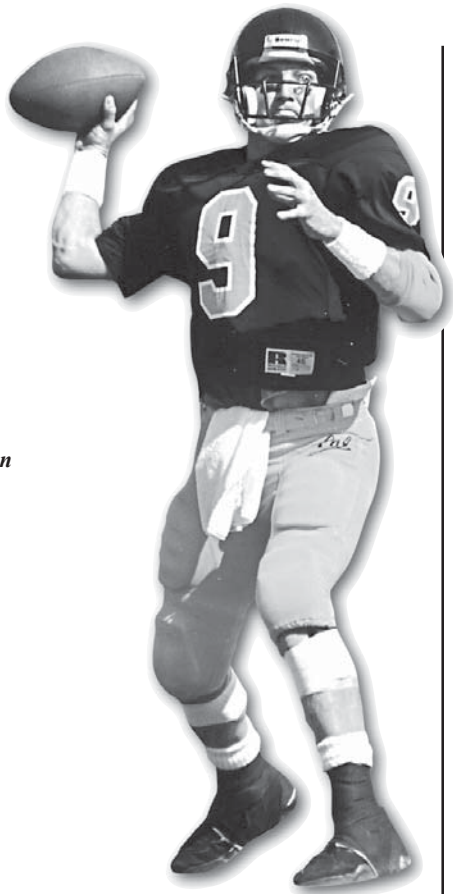

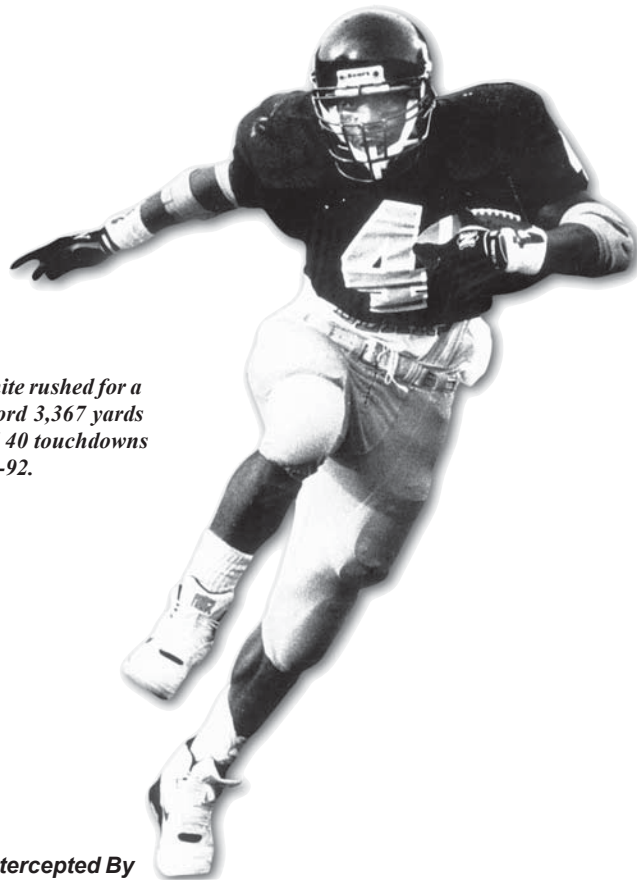

JOE ROTH'S No. 12 JERSEY RETIRED



The only jersey ever retired by the Cal football program is the No. 12 worn by quarterback Joe Roth, who played for the Bears in 1975 and '76.

Roth, who seemed destined to become one of the greatest passers ever produced by Cal, had his career ended by cancer shortly after the '76 season, and he passed away on Feb. 19, 1977. His enormous ability on the football field, friendly openness and humble manner, combined with the courage he showed in facing his illness, made him one of the most popular players ever to wear the Blue and Gold.

Roth still holds the Cal record for longest touchdown pass, an 88-yard hookup with Wesley Walker against Georgia in 1976. Roth's No. 12 jersey was retired during a ceremony on Oct. 29, 1977 prior to the USC game, which Cal won, 17-14.
