SEASON IN REVIEW

California is coming off of an 8-4 season that included a win in the 2005 Pioneer PureVision Las Vegas Bowl (35-28 over Brigham Young). The Bears had some near-misses as well: an overtime loss at Oregon, a three-point setback to Oregon State, and a seven-point loss at UCLA when the Bruins scored 19 points in the last 7:30 of the fourth period. That game was a battle of unbeatens.

BOWL STREAK

California concluded the 2005 season by competing in its third straight bowl game. The Golden Bears had not reached the postseason in three consecutive seasons since the 1948-49-50 Rose Bowl teams.

TWENTY-SOMETHING

The Bears have won 26 games over the past three seasons (26-12). It is the most victories by California over a three-year period since the 1949-1950-1951 teams combined to win 27 games. Nationally, Cal's 18 wins over the last two years rank 13th and the 26 wins over the three-year period are good enough for No. 18 in the country.

MUSICAL STARTERS


California's 2005 achievements are more impressive when considering the injury woes. Along with three different starting quarterbacks, Cal lost leading rusher Marshawn Lynch for nearly three games, nine different offensive linemen made starts during the season, and eight different defensive linemen opened a game, along with five different linebackers.

POLL HISTORY

California finished the 2005 season ranked No. 25 in both the *Associated Press* and *USA Today* football polls. It marked the first time since the 1950 and 1951 seasons that Cal had finished a season ranked in the national polls in consecutive years. The Bears were No. 9 in the 2004 final polls.

MARCH ON MARSHAWN

Marshawn Lynch turned in a stellar sophomore season, his first as a starter at Cal. Despite being limited to less than 10 full games due to injury, Lynch rushed for 1,246 yards in 2005. It was the third best season in Cal history and Lynch ranks as America's second leading returning runner for 2006. Lynch now has 1,874 career rushing yards to already rank ninth in Cal history.

FINISHING IN A RUSH

As Marshawn Lynch became healthier in 2005, his productivity took off. Over the final four regular-season games and the bowl game in Las Vegas, Lynch rushed for an average of 150.6 yards (753 yards over five games). His only game under 100 yards during that period came against top-ranked USC when the sophomore carried the ball just 13 times (but still reached 87 yards).

GRAND TOTALS

Thanks to Marshawn Lynch's 2005 totals, California has now featured a 1,000-yard rusher in four straight seasons. Cal has never had a 1,000-yard rusher in five straight seasons.

SPEAKING OF RUSHING

The Bears ended the 2005 season ninth nationally in rushing (averaging 235.3 yards per game). It marked Cal's second straight season in the nation's top 10 in that category. The Bears were sixth in 2004 with an average of 256.8 rushing yards per game.

TWO-GAME

California will return the nation's most productive running back tandem in Marshawn Lynch (1,246 yards) and Justin Forsett (999 yards). Lynch ended the 2005 season seventh in the NCAA rushing stats and Forsett was No. 50. Only Minnesota, with Laurence Maroney (fifth last season) and Gary Russell (No. 40 in 2005), would have rivaled the returning Cal backs. However, Maroney is not returning for his senior season in Minneapolis.

THE "ALL" GUYS

California returns five players from last year's All-Pac-10 squad. Returning first-teamers include cornerback Daymeion Hughes and defensive lineman Brandon Mebane. Second-team all-league choices that are back in the fold include linebacker Desmond Bishop, special teams standout Byron Storer and defensive end Nu'u Tafisi. Storer was also a second-team Pac-10 all-academic selection.

SCORING IS UP...

California averaged 32.9 points per game during the 2005 season. It was the fourth highest scoring average in Cal history. In fact, of the top five scoring teams in Golden Bears history, four have been coached by Jeff Tedford. Each of Tedford's Cal teams have averaged at least 32 points per game.

...SO ARE TICKETS

Since the arrival of Jeff Tedford, California's season ticket count has been on a steady climb. The Bears sold 16,200 tickets in 2002, Tedford's first year. His second season resulted in sales of 22,500. In 2004, the number again jumped substantially, up to a school-record 34,100. In 2005, California set another record with 40,134 season tickets sold.

SEASON STREAKS

California enters 2006 with an excellent chance of recording its fifth consecutive winning season. That note is significant because Cal has not strung together five straight seasons over the .500 mark since 1948 through 1952. From 1967 through 1971, the Bears did not have a losing season, but two of those records were exactly .500 (5-5).

OTHER TRENDS

California has established a load of positive trends since Jeff Tedford's arrival. California had suffered 19 straight losses its series against the University of Washington. The Bears are 4-0 against the Huskies under Jeff Tedford. Cal also reversed a trend against Stanford, exchanging a seven-game losing streak for another 4-0 record.

THREE UP FRONT

Three California offensive linemen were taken in the 2006 NFL Draft, including Ryan O'Callaghan (fifth round, New England Patriots), Marvin Philip (sixth round, Pittsburgh Steelers) and Aaron Merz (seventh round, Buffalo Bills).






