The Jeff Tedford Era

- California advanced to a fourth consecutive bowl game for the first time in program history in 2006. With the Holiday Bowl victory this past season, Tedford became the first Cal coach with three bowl victories. He also guided the Bears to the Insight Bowl in 2003, the Holiday Bowl in 2004 and the Las Vegas Bowl in 2005.
- Under Tedford, Cal has reached the AP top 10 in each of the last three seasons.
- Cal is one of just three Pac-10 teams that have advanced to bowl games in each of the last four years, and in the Tedford era, the Bears have won the second most Pac-10 games of any team.
- California set a new average attendance record in 2006 at 64,318. The Golden Bears also had a season-ticket record at 40,262 and Cal has now had 18 straight home games with over 50,000 fans.
- The Bears have won 36 games over the past four seasons, the most in a four-year stretch in over 50 years.
- California has won at least seven games in all five seasons under Jeff Tedford and the Bears have won at least eight games in each of the last four seasons.
- During the Tedford era, Cal has had 50 players recognized as Academic All-Conference.
- California had five different players earn All-America recognition in 2006 after having five players on Watch Lists for eight different national awards.
- In 2006, Tedford was named a finalist for the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award which honors the college football coach who best exemplifies responsibility and excellence on and off the field of play.
