# 2005 LAS VEGAS BOWL MEDIA INFORMATION

**TRAVEL INFORMATION:** Due to final examinations, California will not charter to Las Vegas. Team members, coaching staff and members of the official travel party will arrive on four different flights on Dec. 18th and Dec. 19th.

**TEAM AND MEDIA HEADQUARTERS:** The California team and media headquarters for the 2005 Pioneer PureVision Las Vegas Bowl will be at the Hard Rock Hotel, 4455 Paradise Road, Las Vegas, NV 89109. The phone number is (702) 693-5052. BYU will be located in the Golden Nugget Hotel, 129 East Fremont Street, Las Vegas, NV 89125. The phone number is (702) 386-8157.

**TEAM PRACTICE SITE AND DIRECTIONS:** The University of California will practice at Lied Athletic Field at UNLV. Directions to field from Hard Rock Hotel: take Harmon Avenue East (away from the Strip) past Paradise and then past Swenson on to the UNLV campus. Take the first left (unnamed road) between the softball and tennis stadiums. Drive toward the baseball stadium and stop there to park. Lied Athletic Complex is between the baseball stadium and practice fields down a long sidewalk. Entrance the Rebel Park (practice fields) is just outside the Lied Athletic Complex building.

**MEDIA ATTENDANCE AND INTERVIEW POLICIES AT PRACTICE:** All Cal practices, with the exception of the team walk-through Dec. 21 at Sam Boyd Stadium, will be conducted under normal California media policies. The first 10 minutes are open to photographers and video cameras. Players and coaches are available for interviews after each workout. The walk-through on Dec. 21 will be closed to the media.

**CREDENTIALS:** All media attending the Pioneer PureVision Las Vegas Bowl must apply for media and for photo credentials through Mark Wallington at (702) 895-4472. Conference and/or individual school media badges will not be accepted as valid credentials.

**CREDENTIAL DISTRIBUTION:** Media/Photo credentials will not be mailed in advance, but will be available for pick-up at the Pioneer PureVision Las Vegas Bowl Media Center located in the Hard Rock Hotel Conference Room beginning Monday, Dec. 19. Working media members who have not picked up their credentials by Thursday, Dec. 22 may do so at the Sam Boyd Stadium Will Call Window located at the South entrance. The Will Call Window will be open from 1 p.m. until the start of the third quarter.

**MEDIA HOTEL ACCOMODATIONS:** The Hard Rock Hotel is the official media hotel of the Pioneer Purevision Las Vegas Bowl. **REGISTRATION:** Located in the Conference Room at the Hard Rock Hotel, the media may pick up their credentials, parking passes and other information, including media guides, notes and stats.

**MEDIA WORKROOM:** The Pioneer PureVision Las Vegas Bowl Media Center will be located in Conference Room (TBD) at the Hard Rock Hotel. To serve the media in an efficient manner, the Media Center is equipped with a printer, fax machine and telephones. For all outgoing long distance calls, media will be required to use their calling cards or give the operator collect billing instructions. The operator cannot charge any calls to these phones. There will be workstations available and ample electrical power for computers and other electrical equipments. Fax service will be available at the registration desk. The Media Center hours follow:

Monday, Dec. 19 ..... Noon – 5 p.m.  
Tuesday, Dec. 20 ..... 10 a.m. – 3 p.m.  
Wednesday, Dec. 21 ..... 10 a.m. – 3 p.m.

**PRESS BOX:** Entrance into the Sam Boyd Stadium press box is by credential only for the news media and press box staff. A limited number of telephones (restricted long distance) and fax/copy service will be available to the working press. Individual phone requests for the press box must be made by calling Mark Horn, Sam Boyd Communications Manager at (702) 895-1742.

The press box will be open to the media approximately two hours before kickoff. Press releases, statistics, press guides, and flip cards will be available. A pre-game meal will be served only to accredited media approximately 1 ½ hours prior to kick-off. Beverages and snacks will be available throughout the game.

Workspace in the Sam Boyd Stadium press box will be assigned with the following priority:

- 1) National press, newspaper sports/writers from the immediate locale of the event and sports reporters from the immediate locale of the competing teams
- 2) Radio station/network personnel doing play-by-play (broadcast booth space will be assigned)
- 3) Non play-by-play reporters
- 4) Student newspapers and radio stations

**HEAD COACHES PRESS CONFERENCE:** California head coach Jeff Tedford and Bronco Mendenhall of Brigham Young will hold a joint news conference on Wednesday, Dec. 21 at the Las Vegas Convention Center. The news conference will begin at 11 a.m. with the Kickoff Luncheon, featuring ESPN's Lee Corso, to follow at the convention center. The luncheon is scheduled to run from noon until 2 p.m.

**PARKING:** Media parking will be available, but must be noted on your credential application. Media parking is located in the Southeast area of the parking lot. Media should enter through gate # 14.



**PHOTOGRAPHERS/VIDEO:** The Pioneer PureVision Las Vegas Bowl photo credentials must be visible at all times. Bowl organizers will adhere to the NCAA's sideline control policy, which states that:

Sideline photographers are restricted outside the 25-yard lines in the areas designated and are reminded to stay behind the dotted restraining line around the field. No media personnel, including journalist, radio and television personnel or their equipment, shall be in the team area or coaching box.

The photo/video deck is located on the roof of the Wells Fargo tower at Sam Boyd Stadium, which can be reached by one of the two stadium elevators.

**BROADCAST PHONE REQUEST:** Those radio/television stations with permission to broadcast the Pioneer PureVision Las Vegas Bowl should contact Mark Wallington at (702) 895-4472 to coordinate phone hook-up.

**POST-GAME PRESS CONFERENCE AND INTERVIEWS:** Following a 10 minute cooling-off period, post-game interviews will take place in the media tent located directly behind the locker rooms. Only individuals displaying proper credentials will be permitted in the locker room interview area. Security will be posted in these locations and will not allow anyone to obstruct entrances.

The losing coach and selected/requested players will speak and answer questions first, followed by the winning coach and players.

The game's MVP will be announced and the trophy will be awarded during the post-game session.

**GAME TICKETS:** The 2005 Pioneer PureVision Las Vegas Bowl will be played at the 40,000-seat Sam Boyd Stadium on Dec. 22, beginning at 5 p.m. (PST). Tickets can be purchased through the Thomas and Mack Center Ticket Office, 4505 Maryland Parkway, Las Vegas, NV 89154. The phone number is (702) 895-3905. You may also buy tickets online at [www.LVBowl.com](http://www.LVBowl.com) or [www.UNLVTickets.com](http://www.UNLVTickets.com). The ticket office accepts Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover. Tickets for physically challenged individual may be purchased additionally. Boosters and fans may request locations near respective institutional allotments.

**NATIONAL TELEVISION:** ESPN will televise the Pioneer PureVision Las Vegas Bowl on Thursday, Dec. 22 beginning at 5 p.m. (PST). Sean McDonough will call the play-by-play with Mike Gottfried providing analysis. Alex Flanagan will report from the sidelines.

**NATIONAL RADIO:** The game will be syndicated nationally by Sports Radio USA Network. Larry Kahn will be doing the play-by-play, John Robinson will be the analyst, with Troy West on the sideline.

# PIONEER PURE VISION LAS VEGAS BOWL PREVIEW



Since about the time George Washington was chopping down that cherry tree, there has been a debate of some kind or other going on regarding college football.

The first president was probably pulling for — well, Washington (and we all know there is probably at least one fan base that was pulling for the tree).

The current debate has the Bowl Championship Series fans holding the advantage over those pulling for a playoff.

For those, however, heading to the 2005 Pioneer PureVision Las Vegas Bowl, there is no debate. The bowl system is working with all of its benefits on display.

Fans are excited, hotels are filling up, and one of the first choices on the 2005 bowl menu has produced an interesting matchup.

Brigham Young University is heading back to postseason for the first time since the 2001 Liberty Bowl. Under the direction of first-year head coach Bronco Mendenhall, the Cougars look to once again be on the prowl as a program loaded with tradition is back up on the upswing.

California is playing in a third straight bowl game for the first time since the 1948, 1949 and 1950 seasons ended in Rose Bowl appearances. And that streak of postseason dates is stamping Cal as an annual contender for postseason hardware. The climb under Jeff Tedford continues.

Thus the stage is set for two high-powered offenses that are not only looking to complete a solid 2005 season, but also attempting to set the table for a 2006 that is full of promise.

The Mountain West entry from Provo averages 33.5 points per game. The Cougars have scored at least 34 points in each of their last four games. BYU has won five of its last seven contests and the Cougs' 6-5 record has included games against ranked foes Boston College, TCU and Notre Dame.

The Bears match the point total with an average of 32.7 per game. And the Bears' 2005 agenda has featured battles against No. 1 USC, No. 16 UCLA and a top 25 entry from Oregon that has just one loss on the season (to No. 1 USC).

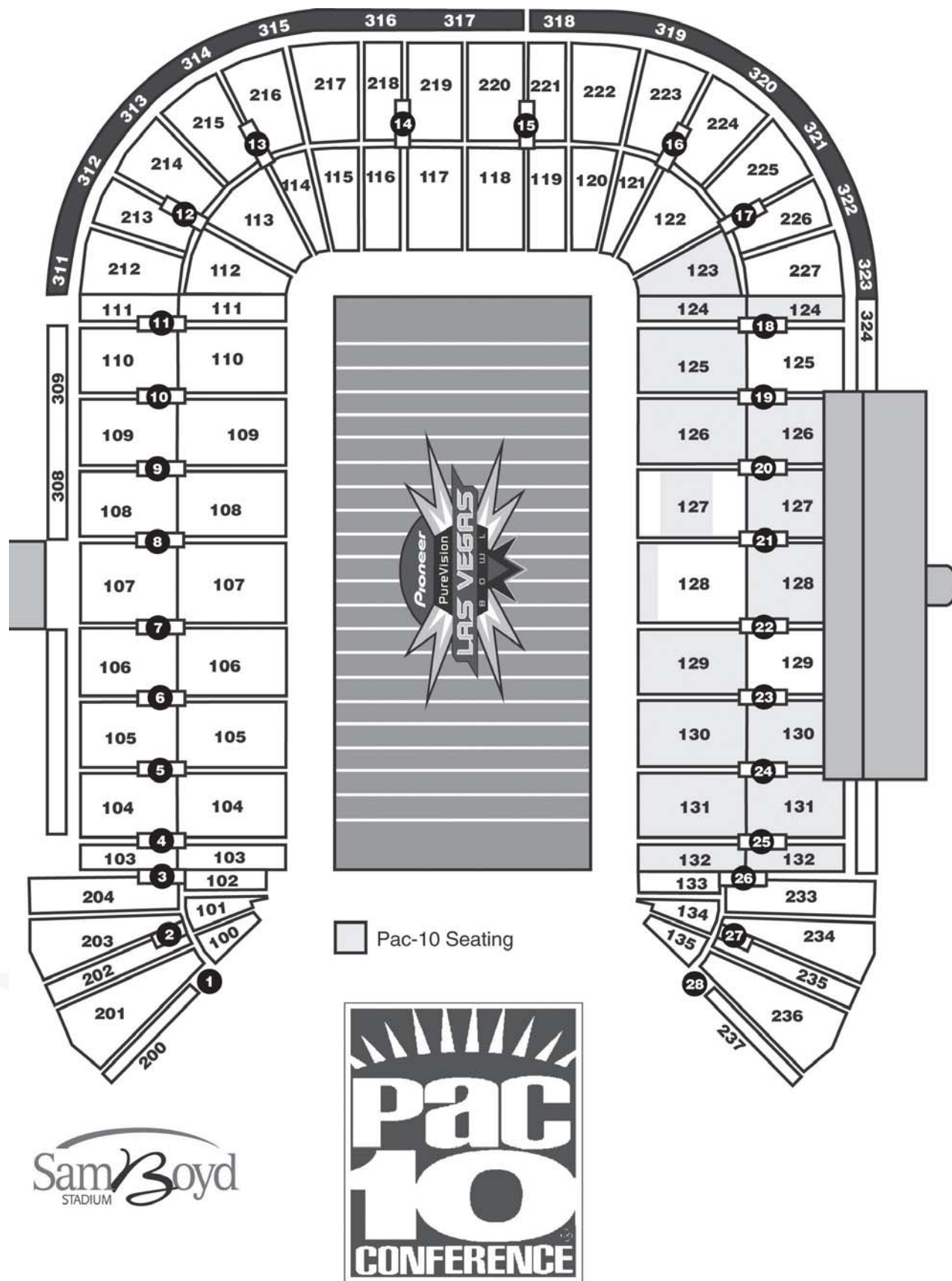
The defense would seem to point to an advantage for the Bears. Cal allows almost nine fewer points and 60 fewer yards per contest. Three of California's 11 opponents this season failed to score an offensive touchdown. In its last outing, California registered nine quarterback sacks in a 27-3 victory over Stanford. The following week, the Cardinal came within an eyelash of upsetting Fiesta-Bowl bound Notre Dame.

Both teams had their share of close calls. BYU was 0-2 in overtime games and had a three-point victory over New Mexico. Cal was 0-1 in overtime and had three other games decided by three points or less.

The bottom line would seem safe to assume. What would Las Vegas be without a show? This game should produce one. Two teams with strong offenses and a habit of close calls could make the 2005 Pioneer PureVision Las Vegas Bowl one of the holiday seasons' best.
