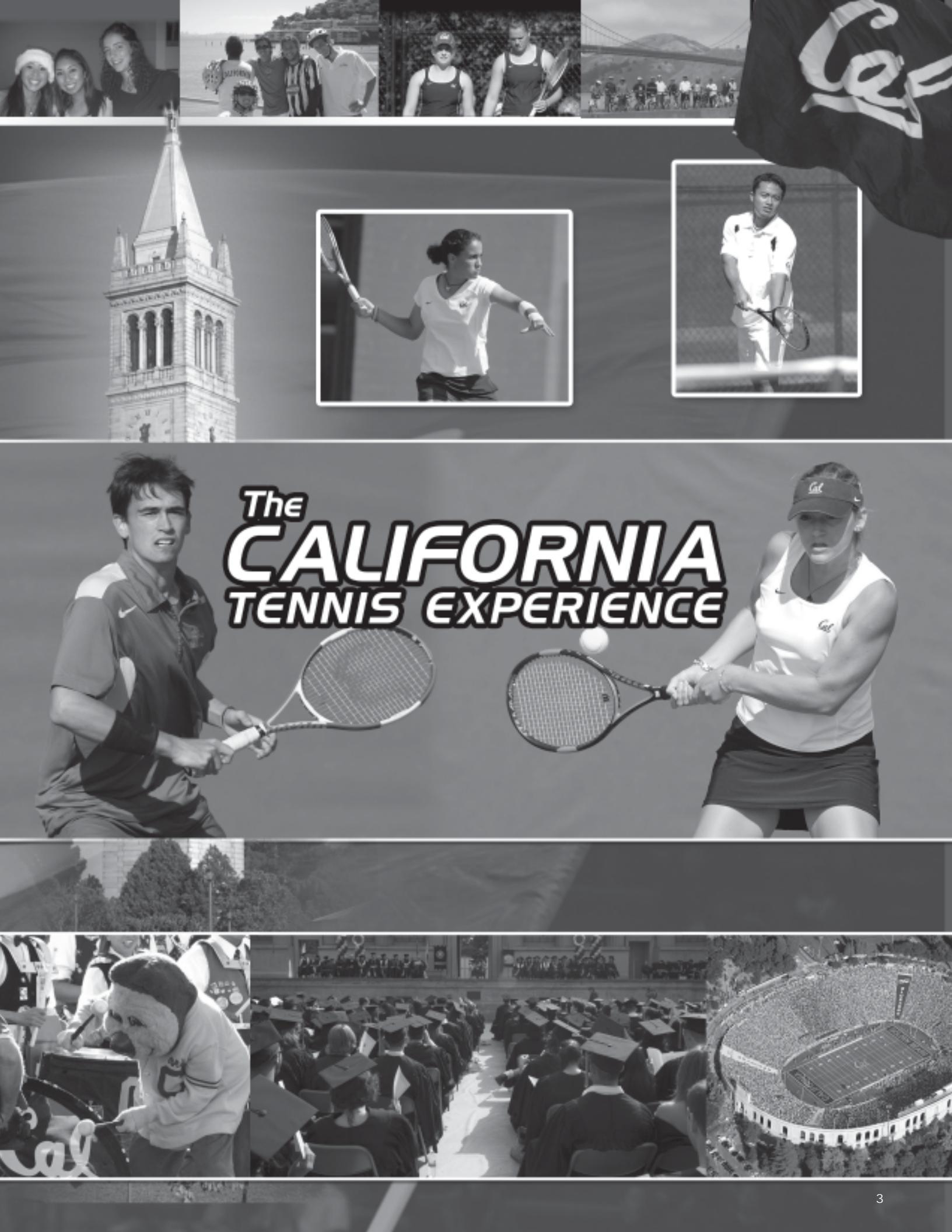

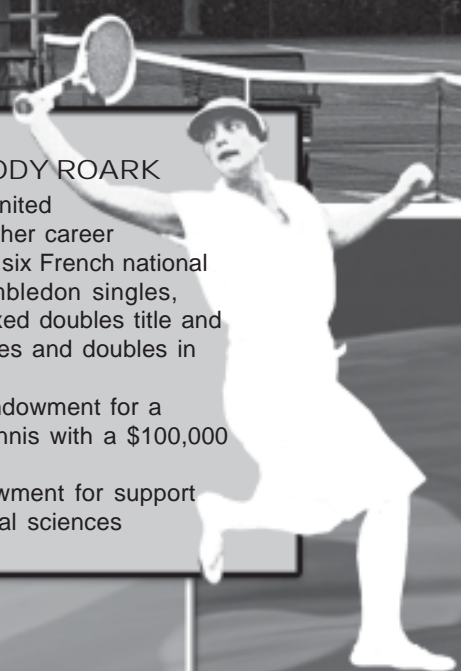

Women's ITA Senior Player of the Year

- HELEN WILLIS MOODY ROARK
- Top-ranked player in the United States seven times during her career
 - Won a total of 13 U.S. and six French national championships, eight Wimbledon singles, three doubles and one mixed doubles title and a gold medal in both singles and doubles in the 1924 Olympics
 - In 1994, established an endowment for a grant-in-aid in women's tennis with a \$100,000 gift to the program
 - Established a major endowment for support of research in the biological sciences

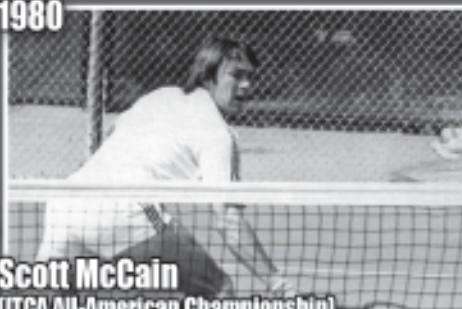

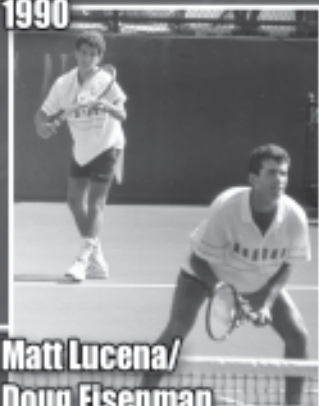

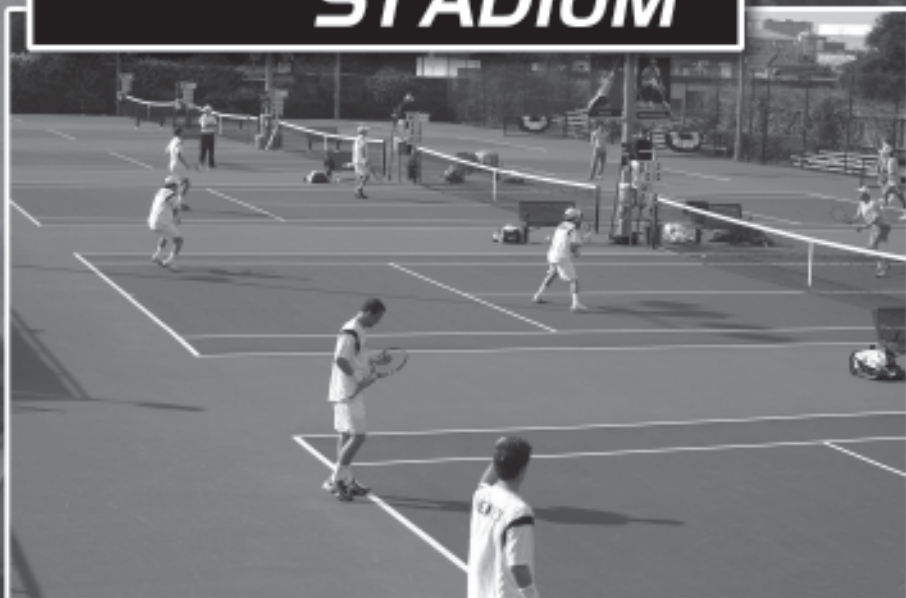

HELLMAN TENNIS STADIUM





Designed by ELS Architecture and Urban Design with top senior player Larry Dodge, the new transformation of Hellman Tennis Center aims to fulfill three primary goals of the University of California and the Cal athletic department:

Maximum Spectator Value: Hellman will retain its intimate atmosphere, but add individual chairback loge seats, viewing lounges and balconies, a modern clubhouse and public restrooms that will help strengthen future Cal tennis bids for NCAA Championships, ATP/WTa tournaments, as well as for charity and junior tennis events.

First Class Team Facilities: Both the men's and women's teams will gain modern offices, locker rooms, meeting rooms and equipment storage areas. These new facilities will be instrumental in creating a superior competitive tennis atmosphere, which will attract top players to Cal.

Community Involvement: By adding team rooms that can be converted to classroom space in the evenings, the new facility will enhance the Bear Trax program. Bear Trax is an academic and athletic exchange program which supports disadvantaged students from the Bay Area in their transition from low-income communities to higher education campuses.
