Even with the long list of returning standouts, Everist and his staff have several additional talented young stars. True freshmen Mike Hayes, Michael Sharf and Zac Monsees are all in contention for substantial playing time. Hayes is a strong offensive player who was a threetime All-American and 2004 CIF Central Coast Section Player of the Year at Bellarmine College Prep in San Jose. Sharf is a 6-3 driver from Miramonte High School in Orinda, who was a two-time All-American and the 2003 North Coast Section MVP. He was teammates with Mann and Matthies this past summer on the USA Junior National Team that won the gold medal at Junior Pan American Games in San Salvador.

Monsees is an impressive athlete who was a two-time All-American in water polo at Leland High School in San Jose, scoring 144 goals as a senior. He is also an outstanding swimmer, and will be competing for the Bears'

swim team this year, as well.

Additional depth will be provided by senior Alex Niehenke, junior Tom Kurth, sophomores Dan Werner and Jeff Smith, and redshirt freshmen Adam Haley, Kevin Platshon, Cameron Jones, Matt MacLachlan and Jeff Tyrrell. This large group has all shown the ability to contribute this season, both offensively and defensively. Werner, Haley, Platshon, Jones and Tyrrell were members of the Lamorinda Water Polo Club that has excelled in Junior Olympic and 20-Under National competition the past two years.

"Early on in the season we will work on building depth," said Everist. "We need to trust in the process and

hopefully by the end of the year we will show the type of depth we believe we have. For our young players, it is now their team. It is all about getting our guys to play well together."
