26TH ANNUAL RAINBOW WAHINE CLASSIC

California travels to Honolulu, Hawai'i Thanksgiving weekend for Hawaii Airlines' 26th-annual Rainbow Wahine Classic. The eight-team tournament is staged Friday-Sunday, Nov. 26-28, 2004, at the Stan Sheriff Center. This year's field includes Cal, host-Hawaii, three 2004 NCAA Tournament teams – Georgia, Michigan State and TCU – as well as Utah, Idaho and Santa Clara. Each team is guaranteed to play three games.

The Golden Bears open the tournament against TCU Friday at 12:40 p.m. local time. Cal then faces either Georgia or Idaho in Saturday's second round. The winner's bracket game is at 5:30 p.m., while the losers will meet at 11 a.m. If the Bears should win their first two games, they will play for the championship on Sunday at 5:30 p.m.

Cal is making its fourth appearance in the Rainbow Wahine Classic. In 1987, Cal lost to Hawai'i (62-58), defeated Oklahoma (81-66) and lost to UCLA (75-50). At the 1993 tournament, the Bears downed Alaska-Anchorage (82-62) before falling to Hawai'i (98-73) and San Francisco (75-62). In 1997, Cal suffered setbacks to Hawai'i (69-40) and UW-Green Bay (59-58) and triumphed over Marshall (66-59).
