Three Bears Named to Pac-10 All-Academic Team

BERKELEY – Led by senior pitcher **Kelly Anderson's** second-consecutive first team selection, three California softball seniors were named to the 2005 Pacific-10 All-Academic squad, announced June 6. Joining Anderson was second team member **Jessica Pamanian** and honorable mention pick **Kaleo Eldredge**.

Anderson, named to the first team in 2004 and the second team in 2003, graduated this past May with a degree in legal studies and a 3.36 overall GPA. She won a career-high 28 games in 2005 to help Cal reach its seventh-straight Women's College World Series and has plans to attend law school in the fall. Her 83 career victories are fourth in program history.

Pamanian was a second team pick last season and an honorable mention selection as a sophomore. A four-year starter at second base, Pamanian graduated from Cal with a 3.32 GPA and a psychology degree. She leaves Cal fourth all-time in at-bats (819) and tied for fourth in games played (271).

On May 12, Anderson and Pamanian were also selected to the CoSIDA District VIII Academic All-America first team.

Eldredge, a four-year starter in center field, earned a degree in American Studies. This was her first selection to the Pac-10 All-Academic team. Eldredge departs the Bear program as the school's all-time leader in runs scored (160) and is fourth in hits (239).

The Bears (52-15) concluded their season June 4, with a 3-2, 12-inning loss to Arizona in the loser's bracket of the WCWS.
