THIS WEEK: The No. 8-ranked California women's tennis team (16-4, 6-1 Pac-10) will complete its regular season schedule as the Golden Bears host No. 12 Stanford (17-3, 6-1 Pac-10) on Saturday, April 18, at noon in the Big Slam at the Hellman Tennis Complex. Cal will honor seniors **Bojana Bobusic**, **Claire Ilcinkas** and **Marion Ravelojaona** in pre-match ceremonies as the Cardinal and the Bears clash for a potential share of the Pac-10 team championship. Although No. 9-ranked USC (19-2, 7-0 Pac-10) has already secured a portion of the conference title, if the Women of Troy fall to No. 10 UCLA (17-5, 5-2 Pac-10) on Friday, Cal and Stanford will be meeting for a piece of the Pac-10 crown on Saturday; the Bears with revenge on their minds. The last time the two teams met, Cal nabbed the upper hand by winning a thrilling doubles point at the top court, but the Cardinal rebounded by coming from behind to claim victories on four singles courts and prevailed with a 4-3 decision at Taube Family Tennis Center in Stanford, Calif. This weekend's match will feature live webcasts from each court via links available at the women's tennis page on CalBears.com.

ON COURT - NO. 12 STANFORD: The Cardinal (17-3, 6-1 Pac-10) has won 12 of its last 13 matches and five in a row since a 5-2 loss to conference leader USC. Stanford stayed the pace with Cal over the weekend by defeating Oregon and Pepperdine in 7-0 sweeps to set up a potential faceoff for a piece of the Pac-10 championship. The Cardinal is led by No. 9-ranked sophomore **Hilary Barte**, who has recorded a 19-1 record at the top singles court, 27-4 overall. No. 82-ranked senior **Jessica Nguyen** has built up a 17-3 dual record (18-7 overall) this season and is undefeated at the third singles court, 9-0. Sophomore **Carolyn McVeigh** ranks second on the team with a 23-8 overall record (17-4 in duals) and No. 89-ranked junior **Lindsay Burdette** has put together a 20-7 record with a 16-4 mark in duals. The Cardinal lineup also boasts two of the top-50 ranked doubles teams in the country. No. 10-ranked Barte and Burdette lead the team with a 19-7 record (16-4 in duals at the top court) and No. 46-ranked McVeigh and Nguyen are 17-3 on the year with a 16-3 mark at the second court. The Cardinal won the first meeting against Cal this year down at The Farm, by coming from behind to pull off a 4-3 stunner. Looking ahead to the 69th meeting between the two teams, Stanford leads the all-time series by a 60-8 advantage.

LAST WEEK: The Bears earned their third consecutive 7-0 victory (sixth of the year) as Cal defeated No. 56 Oregon and No. 45 Pepperdine without dropping any doubles matches and without losing a single set in all 12 singles matches. The Bears dominated from start to finish and earned their fifth consecutive victory to match a season high. Freshman **Jana Juricova** and senior **Bojana Bobusic** stayed neck-and-neck as each earned their 33rd singles victories of the year. Bobusic's 6-0, 6-1 win against Danielle Thomasma of Pepperdine was her 14th in a row and put her dual record at 19-1 on the season with a 7-0 mark in Pac-10 duals. Senior **Claire Ilcinkas** got her 25th and 26th wins of the year and sophomore **Marina Cossou** returned to singles action for the first time since March 21 to pick up two victories. Senior **Marion Ravelojaona** got her 20th singles win of the year when she defeated Siobhan Cavan of Oregon. Sophomore **Mari Andersson** and Juricova teamed up to get their 11th-consecutive win at the top doubles court and have recorded a 17-1 mark together. Cossou and Ilcinkas kept pace and got their 17th win of the year as well while Bobusic and freshman **Stephany Chang** posted their seventh win of the dual season together (3-1 Pac-10).

BEARS IN THE RANKS: The Bears are ranked No. 8 as a team in the most recent (April 14) Campbell's/ITA (Intercollegiate Tennis Association) College Tennis Poll. Cal has five ranked singles players with eighth-ranked freshman **Jana Juricova** at the top of that list. Senior **Bojana Bobusic** is No. 26 and sophomore **Marina Cossou** is No. 27. Sophomore **Mari Andersson** holds the No. 36 ranking and senior **Claire Ilcinkas** is ranked No. 49 to give the Bears five singles players among the top 50 in the nation. Cal's arsenal also includes three of the top doubles teams in the country as Andersson and Juricova combine for the No. 5 ranking; Cossou and Ilcinkas become the No. 22-ranked doubles team; and Bobusic and Juricova are ranked No. 51.

POWER OF THE PAC: Eight of the Pac-10's women's tennis teams hold rankings in the latest Campbell's/ITA College Tennis Poll of NCAA Division I Women's Tennis teams—making the Pac-10 one of the toughest leagues in collegiate women's tennis. The Bears lead the way at No. 8; followed closely by ninth-ranked USC. No. 10 UCLA and No. 12 Stanford come up next with Arizona State at No. 29 and Washington at No. 30 to give the conference five teams in the top-30 alone. Oregon checks in at No. 64 and Arizona at No. 68. Washington State cracked the rankings for the first time on March 17 at No. 74 but has since fallen off. Last year, Cal and UCLA battled it out in the NCAA team championship match to give the conference full control of the national title. Three Pac-10 teams made the NCAA quarterfinals and four made it as far as the round of 16. The conference also produced two NCAA singles championship quarterfinalists and the doubles national champion among its 10 ITA All-Americans. Four of those All-American were Bears including currently active senior **Claire Ilcinkas** and sophomore **Marina Cossou** as well as Susie Babos and Stephanie Kusano.

BEARS COLLECTING WEEKLY CONFERENCE HONORS: Three Bears have won Pac-10 Women's Tennis Player of the Week honors this season to give Cal nine such awards all time; the most of any Pac-10 team. Sophomore **Mari Andersson** won the award for the week of Feb. 9-15 and freshman **Jana Juricova** took home honors for the week of March 9-15. Senior **Bojana Bobusic** claimed the prize for the week of March 16-22 to make it the first time in school history that Cal has had three winners in the same season.

AUGUSTUS SELECTED TO LEAD USTA WOMEN'S SUMMER COLLEGIATE TEAM: Head coach **Amanda Augustus** was selected by the United States Tennis Association to coach the 2009 USTA Women's Summer Collegiate Team along with Princeton head coach Kathy Sell. The USTA began the summer program in 1996 as an elite training program for the top American collegiate tennis players. The teams will be named in May, after the NCAA championships and will include 12 men and 12 women from the top collegiate tennis programs in the country. This summer, for the first time, USTA Player Development will host two Pro Tour Transition camps—one for men and one for women—for the selected players. The men's camp will be held June 20-23 in Boca Raton, Fla. while the women's camp will be conducted July 6-9 in Atlanta, Ga.

BOBUSIC NAMED PAC-10 PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Senior **Bojana Bobusic** was named the Pac-10's women's tennis player of the week for the week of March 16-22 as she emerged from play with a perfect record in all four of her matches. She became the third Cal player to win the honors this season as she helped the Bears to a 5-2 win over No. 42 Denver and a narrow 4-3 loss to No. 18-ranked Fresno State. Bobusic ran her singles record to 27-7 overall with a 13-1 mark in dual matches as she defeated Denver's Ute Schnoy at No. 3 singles, 6-2, 6-2. She then took out Fresno State's Tinesta Rowe at No. 4 singles, 7-6(4), 4-6, 7-5 for her eighth straight singles victory. In doubles play, she teamed up with freshman **Jana Juricova** for just their fifth and sixth matches together (first since the fall) and got two big wins to help Cal win the doubles point for the 10th time this year. The duo claimed an 8-2 win over Julia Bauregger and Mallory Voelker of Denver on the top court in their first match. Then in their second match, they fought out an 8-5 win over top-ranked Renata Kucerkova and Anastasia Petukhova of Fresno State. This was Bobusic's first such honor and the ninth all-time for the Cal women.

INDOOR HONORS: Senior **Claire Ilcinkas** and sophomore **Mari Andersson** were each named to the 2009 ITA National Team Indoor Championship All-Tournament Team. Andersson held the third-court position while Ilcinkas took fourth-court honors. The two each went 3-0 in singles matches at the annual team tournament and picked up two wins each with their doubles partners as the Bears advanced to the semifinal match for the first time since 2004. The pair was joined by four other singles players and three doubles teams on the all-tournament team. Representing the top court was Chelsey Gullickson of Georgia, who was also named the tournament's most outstanding player. Court two honors belonged to Duke's Ellah Nze. On court five, Georgia had Naoko Ueshima while Shannon Matthews of Notre Dame rounded out the singles players on court six. All three doubles teams came from Northwestern: Georgia Rose and Lauren Lui on the top court, Maria Mosolova and Keri Robison on court two and Samantha Murray and Elena Chernyakova on court three. Ilcinkas and Andersson became the first two Bears to receive all-tournament honors at the Indoor Championships.

HELLMAN TENNIS COMPLEX

California tennis makes its home at the Hellman Tennis Complex, located on the southwest side of the Berkeley campus. Used for practice, tournaments and home dual matches, Hellman has served as the host facility for the 1996 Men's Rolex NorCal Regional Tournament and was the site of the 1994 NCTA/Michael Chang Reach for the Stars tennis clinic that benefited underprivileged Northern California youths, as well as numerous NCAA regional competitions.

Built in 1983 with a grant from the S.H. Cowell Foundation, the Hellman Tennis Complex was formally dedicated by the University in October of that year. From 1983-91, Hellman housed the offices of both men's track and field and men's tennis. The merging of the men's and women's athletic departments relocated the women's tennis staff to Hellman in 1991. The facility's office has been exclusively used for tennis ever since.

The complex honors the late Isias Warren Hellman III, a Cal alumnus (A.B., 1920), former chair of the Cowell Foundation and the former president and chair of Wells Fargo Bank. Hellman was one of Cal's most prominent and active donors and was responsible for university contributions for Friends of the Bancroft Library and the Alumni House and Barrows Hall.

In 1993, stadium lights were added to Hellman Tennis Complex, a direct result of the work of former Oakland Athletics owner Walter Haas. Haas, a Cal tennis letterwinner in 1927, spearheaded the Cal Sports' 80's fund-raising campaign, which brought campus-wide improvements to all of Cal's athletic facilities.

In 2004, new logo-style chairback seats were installed in the eastern viewing section of the stadium, giving Hellman the look and feel it has today. Future renovations to the complex include plans designed by ELS Architecture and Urban Design with the help of top senior player Larry Dodge. The newly renovated complex will provide viewing lounges, balconies, a modern clubhouse and public restroom facilities as well as new offices, locker rooms and meeting rooms for the teams.

In the summer of 2008, as a tribute to legendary women's head coach Jan Brogan, the generous donation of former California women's tennis player Stacy Savides Sullivan (1982-85) allowed the Golden Bears to install a new state-of-the-art scoreboard. The scoreboard sits on the south side of the complex.

THOMAS STOW PLAZA

Stow Plaza was constructed during the fall of 1994 to honor its namesake, Thomas Stow, the 1926 NCAA doubles champion and former California coach. Formally dedicated upon its completion in January 1995, Stow Plaza brought a face-lift to Hellman Tennis Complex, creating a new main entrance and landscaped patio for Cal's tennis facility.

Thomas Stow was a legend in Cal tennis history, partnering with the great Bud Chandler to win the 1926 NCAA doubles championship before graduating from Cal in 1927. He returned as head coach from 1932-46. During his time at the helm for the Bears, Stow compiled a 73-45-1 (.618) coaching record, leading Cal to three Pacific Coast Conference championships. He was inducted into Cal's Athletic Hall of Fame in 1987.

CAL AT THE ITA INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS: The Bears made their fourth consecutive appearance at the indoor championship and advanced to the semifinal for the first time since 2004. Cal has now won its opening match in seven of its last nine visits to Madison, Wis. for the annual tournament. The Bears rank sixth among all teams for most wins at the championship with 24 and are only one of 11 teams that can claim they have made it to the final of the championship, earning runner-up status in 2000. In the second year of its existence, senior **Claire Ilcinkas** and sophomore **Mari Andersson** earned honors on the Indoor Championship All-Tournament Team; Ilcinkas on the fourth singles court and Andersson on the third.

FALL 2008 REVIEW: The Bears were highly successful in fall individual tournaments in 2008. Senior **Bojana Bobusic** advanced to the Wilson/ITA Northwest Regional Singles Championship match and earned an automatic berth to the ITA National Indoor Championships along with All-Americans sophomore **Marina Cossou** and senior **Claire Ilcinkas**. Freshman **Jana Juricova** put her name on the map as she posted a team-best 17-2 overall singles record. She won the Saint Mary's Invitational singles title and the ASU Thunderbird Invitational singles title and joined forces with Rachael Dillon to win the doubles championship at the Saint Mary's Invitational as well. Senior **Marion Ravelojaona** returned from a leg injury a year ago to claim the Cal Nike Invitational Blue Flight singles championship in the early fall.

JENSEN RETURNS TO BERKELEY: A four-time All-American selection and two-time All-Conference selection while at Cal, Denver head coach **Amy Jensen** returned to face her alma mater as a head coach for the first time when the Denver Pioneers invaded Hellman Tennis Complex on March 19. The Bears emerged with a 5-2 victory. Jensen won the 1998 and 1999 NCAA doubles championship with Cal head coach **Amanda Augustus** and retained the title one more year as she won the 2000 crown with **Claire Curran**. Jensen served as Cal's assistant and associate head coach from 2001-2006 under the guidance of **Jan Brogan**. In her second season as head coach of the Pioneers, Jensen guided Denver to its finest season in school history with a 23-3 record, Sun Belt Conference championship and NCAA Tournament appearance. In 2007, Jensen led the Pioneers to a 14-9 record and third place finish at the Sun Belt Conference championship. While at Cal, she posted a career record of 105-52 in singles and a remarkable 94-29 record in doubles. She had a career high singles ranking of No. 9 and finished with a national doubles ranking of No. 2 for three consecutive years. Jensen graduated from Cal in May 2002 with a pre-med degree in integrative biology.

HEAD COACH AMANDA AUGUSTUS: In just her first season at the helm for the Golden Bears, head coach **Amanda Augustus** led Cal to a program-best finish as the NCAA championship runner up in 2008. Augustus recorded a 21-6 overall record and helped Cal to a third place finish in the Pac-10 with a 6-2 conference mark. The Bears completed the season with the No. 3 ranking, which was also the highest finish in Cal history. In just two seasons as a collegiate head coach, Augustus has solidified a 54-18 (.750) overall record and proven that her squads will be ones to be reckoned with, producing four ITA All-American selections in her first season at Cal and pushing the Bears to heights not reached before. As a player, Augustus earned All-American honors six times (twice for doubles, four times for singles) and All-Pac-10 honors in each of her four years. She teamed with Amy Jensen to capture the NCAA title in both 1998 and 1999 and became the first tandem to win back-to-back doubles championships.
