2011 TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS



BERKELEY – The ninth-ranked California women's tennis team (16-6, 6-2 Pac-10) was selected as the ninth seed in the 2011 NCAA Division I Women's Tennis Championships on Tue., May 3. The Golden Bears have been chosen to play in every NCAA tournament and will make their 30th appearance as hosts of the first and second rounds. Cal will welcome USC (14-7), Saint Mary's College (13-9), and Boston University (12-8) for dual matches on May 14 and 15 at the Hellman Tennis Complex.

The Women of Troy finished fifth in the Pac-10 and will make their 20th consecutive appearance in the tennis championships. In its 29th overall appearance, USC will face the Gaels—who finished third in the West Coast Conference—in a 9 a.m. PT first-round match on Sat., May 14. Saint Mary's College earned its second selection to the NCAA tournament on an at-large bid.

In the other first-round matchup, Cal draws Boston University for a dual at noon PT. The Terriers won their 18th straight America East Conference title and earned the program's 13th consecutive NCAA berth.

The winners of each first-round match will face each other in a second-round dual on Sun., May 15, at noon PT. The winner of the second-round match will advance to the round of 16 which begins on Fri., May 20, at the Taube Family Tennis Stadium on the campus of championship host Stanford in Stanford, Calif.

Ticket prices are \$10 for adults, and \$5 for seniors (65+), students (with valid identification), and youth (K-12). All tickets will be sold at the Hellman Tennis Complex entrance on the day of the matches. There are no advanced ticket sales available.

The Bears enter the NCAA championships after earning third place in the ultra-competitive Pac-10 Conference. All but two of the league's nine teams earned bids into the tournament this season with defending national champion Stanford holding the top overall seed.

Cal's lineup boasts five ranked singles players, led by the nation's top individual in junior Jana Juricova. The Piestany, Slovak Republic native is 29-3 in singles matches this season, and holds a perfect 19-0 mark in dual matches at the top court. Senior Mari Andersson is ranked No. 23 and recorded 27 victories this year. The Bears' sophomores have each eclipsed 30 singles wins this season. No. 55-ranked Taylor Davis has 31 victories and is just two shy of team-leader No. 84 Annie Goransson. Freshman Anett Schutting has come on strong late in this spring and now holds the 104th spot in the singles rankings with nine wins.

Andersson and Juricova form the top-ranked doubles team in the nation. The duo leads the team with a 38-6 mark this year. The two Bears captured the Pac-10 doubles crown, and are a threat to win a second NCAA title after they claimed the 2009 championship. Goransson and Schutting team up to form the No. 30-ranked doubles team in the country. Cal won the doubles point 15 times this season and went undefeated in each of those dual matches.

The Bears are 53-30 (.639) in NCAA tournament matches. In head coach Amanda Augustus' first two seasons on campus, she led Cal to its two best postseason finishes as NCAA runners-up in 2008 and 2009. Last season, the Bears hosted and defeated Southern (4-0) and USC (4-1) to advance to the round of 16, but were edged by Notre Dame, 4-2.

SWEDES EARN PAC-10 PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS: Sophomore **Annie Goransson** (Hollviken, Sweden) was chosen as the Pac-10's women's tennis player of the week for Jan. 31-Feb. 6, and senior **Mari Andersson** (Bastad, Sweden) was selected for the week of Feb. 14-20. Goransson received her first-career honor after she earned an impressive 6-1, 6-2 win over UCLA's No. 36-ranked Courtney Dolehide from the No. 4 singles spot to help the Bears upset the fourth-ranked Bruins, 4-3. She became the ninth different Cal player to receive the award. In doubles play, Goransson teamed with fellow sophomore **Taylor Davis** to defeat UCLA's Pamela Montez and Carling Seguso, 8-6. Andersson received her second-career POW honor after she went undefeated in all six of her matches at the 2011 ITA National Team Indoor Championships. She passed the 15-win mark in singles and maintained a perfect mark in duals (8-0). In doubles, with the help of junior **Jana Juricova**, the pair tacked up a team-leading 24th victory to extend their winning streak to 11 straight.

BEARS IN THE RANKS: The Bears are ranked No. 9 as a team in the most recent (May 2) Campbell's/ITA (Intercollegiate Tennis Association) College Tennis Poll. Cal has four ranked singles players among the top 75 players in the nation. Junior **Jana Juricova** leads the way for the Bears as the top-ranked player in the country. Senior **Mari Andersson** is ranked No. 25 and Cal's sophomore duo received their first singles rankings on January 4. **Taylor Davis** now ranks No. 55 and **Annie Goransson** comes in at No. 84. Freshman **Anett Schutting** received her first singles ranking on May 2 at No. 104. Andersson and Juricova hold the top ranking as a doubles team, and Goransson teams with Schutting for the No. 30 spot among doubles teams.

HELLMAN TENNIS COMPLEX

California tennis makes its home at the Hellman Tennis Complex, located on the southwest side of the Berkeley campus. Used for practice, tournaments and home dual matches, Hellman has served as the host facility for the 1996 Men's Rolex NorCal Regional Tournament and was the site of the 1994 NCTA/Michael Chang Reach for the Stars tennis clinic that benefited underprivileged Northern California youths, as well as numerous NCAA regional competitions.

Built in 1983 with a grant from the S.H. Cowell Foundation, the Hellman Tennis Complex was formally dedicated by the University in October of that year. From 1983-91, Hellman housed the offices of both men's track and field and men's tennis. The merging of the men's and women's athletic departments relocated the women's tennis staff to Hellman in 1991. The facility's office has been exclusively used for tennis ever since.

The complex honors the late Isias Warren Hellman III, a Cal alumnus (A.B., 1920), former chair of the Cowell Foundation and the former president and chair of Wells Fargo Bank. Hellman was one of Cal's most prominent and active donors and was responsible for university contributions for Friends of the Bancroft Library and the Alumni House and Barrows Hall.

In 1993, stadium lights were added to Hellman Tennis Complex, a direct result of the work of former Oakland Athletics owner Walter Haas. Haas, a Cal tennis letterwinner in 1927, spearheaded the Cal Sports' 80's fund-raising campaign, which brought campus-wide improvements to all of Cal's athletic facilities.

In 2004, new logo-style chairback seats were installed in the eastern viewing section of the stadium, giving Hellman the look and feel it has today. Future renovations to the complex include plans designed by ELS Architecture and Urban Design with the help of top senior player Larry Dodge. The newly renovated complex will provide viewing lounges, balconies, a modern clubhouse and public restroom facilities as well as new offices, locker rooms and meeting rooms for the teams.

In the summer of 2008, as a tribute to legendary women's head coach Jan Brogan, the generous donation of former California women's tennis player Stacy Savides Sullivan (1982-85) allowed the Golden Bears to install a new state-of-the-art scoreboard. The scoreboard sits on the south side of the complex.

THOMAS STOW PLAZA

Stow Plaza was constructed during the fall of 1994 to honor its namesake, Thomas Stow, the 1926 NCAA doubles champion and former California coach. Formally dedicated upon its completion in January 1995, Stow Plaza brought a face-lift to Hellman Tennis Complex, creating a new main entrance and landscaped patio for Cal's tennis facility.

Thomas Stow was a legend in Cal tennis history, partnering with the great Bud Chandler to win the 1926 NCAA doubles championship before graduating from Cal in 1927. He returned as head coach from 1932-46. During his time at the helm for the Bears, Stow compiled a 73-45-1 (.618) coaching record, leading Cal to three Pacific Coast Conference championships. He was inducted into Cal's Athletic Hall of Fame in 1987.

POWER OF THE PAC: Seven of the Pac-10's nine women's tennis teams hold rankings in the latest Campbell's/ITA College Tennis Poll of NCAA Division I Women's Tennis teams—making the Pac-10 one of the toughest leagues in collegiate women's tennis. Defending conference and NCAA champion Stanford leads all teams with the No. 2 ranking with UCLA just a few spots back at No. 6. Cal is up next at No. 9. Arizona State checks in at No. 17 with USC at No. 18 to give the league five teams in the top 20 alone. Washington is ranked No. 28 with Arizona at No. 34 to put all seven teams in the top 35. Oregon and Washington State each held rankings earlier in the season. Last season, Stanford won the national title, with three teams advancing at least as far as the round of 16, including Cal. Two years ago, Cal represented the conference in the NCAA title match with four teams advancing as far as the round of 16; and three seasons ago, Cal and UCLA battled it out in the NCAA team championship match to give the conference full control of the national title. The conference also produced the 2009 NCAA doubles champion; **Mari Andersson** and **Jana Juricova**. Juricova also won the 2009 ITA Indoor Championship singles title and finished as the runner-up for the 2010 NCAA singles crown. Players from the Pac-10 have won the NCAA doubles title in each of the last three years, and a team from the conference has claimed the NCAA title 19 times since 1982.

INTERNATIONAL FLAVOR: The Bears are a truly diverse group with players hailing from five different countries. Senior **Mari Andersson** and sophomore **Annie Goransson** each come from Sweden; junior **Jana Juricova** is from the Slovak Republic; freshman **Alice Duranteau** and senior **Marina Cossou** are each native of France; and freshman **Anett Schutting** is from Estonia. Juniors **Stephany Chang** and **Catalina Visico**, and sophomore **Tayler Davis** are each from California.

FAMILY TIES: Junior **Catalina Visico** is the younger sister of former Cal tennis standout **Cristina Visico** (2004-08). While she prefers to be called **Catie**, Catalina has forged her own identity with the Bears as a vocal leader and an integral part of the team. The elder Visico was a 2008 All-Pac-10 Honorable mention and completed her career at Cal with over 100 singles victories and 40 doubles wins. She returned to the Bears this season as their volunteer assistant coach.

DO YOU KNOW THE WAY TO SAN JOSE?: Junior **Stephany Chang** and sophomore **Tayler Davis** each hail from the South Bay's Silicon Valley city of San Jose. Chang attended Laurel Springs High School while Davis prepped at Archbishop Mitty High School.

FRENCH CONNECTION: Senior **Marina Cossou** (Azereix, France) and freshman **Alice Duranteau** (Paris, France) teamed up for a pair of doubles matches this season. The two share more than just tennis in common, though. They each come from France; Duranteau from the bright city lights of its capital, Paris, and Cossou from a small town 500 miles away in the south of the country.

HEAD COACH AMANDA AUGUSTUS: In just four seasons at the helm for the Golden Bears, head coach **Amanda Augustus** led the Cal program to four postseason appearances, including two consecutive NCAA championship matches and produced nine ITA All-America selections. The Bears finished as the national runner up in 2008 and 2009, and have experienced many individual successes along the way. **Mari Andersson** and **Jana Juricova** teamed to claim the 2009 NCAA doubles championship while Juricova earned Cal's first-ever ITA Indoor singles title in the fall of 2009. Juricova went on to finish as the NCAA singles runner-up in the spring of 2010. Augustus recorded a 21-6 overall record and helped Cal to a third place Pac-10 finish with a 6-2 conference mark in her first season on campus. The Bears completed the year with the ITA's No. 3 ranking, which tied for the highest finish in Cal history. As an encore, she led the Bears to a 22-5 record in her second year and brought Cal a second-place finish in the conference with a 7-1 league record. In just four seasons as a collegiate head coach, Augustus has solidified a 96-31 (.756) overall record and proven that her squads will be ones to be reckoned with. As a player, Augustus earned All-America honors six times (twice for doubles and four times for singles) and All-Pac-10 honors in each of her four years at Berkeley. As a freshman, she earned Cal's second ITA All-American doubles crown. Augustus later teamed with **Amy Jensen** to capture the NCAA doubles title in both 1998 and 1999 and became the second tandem to win back-to-back NCAA doubles championships.
