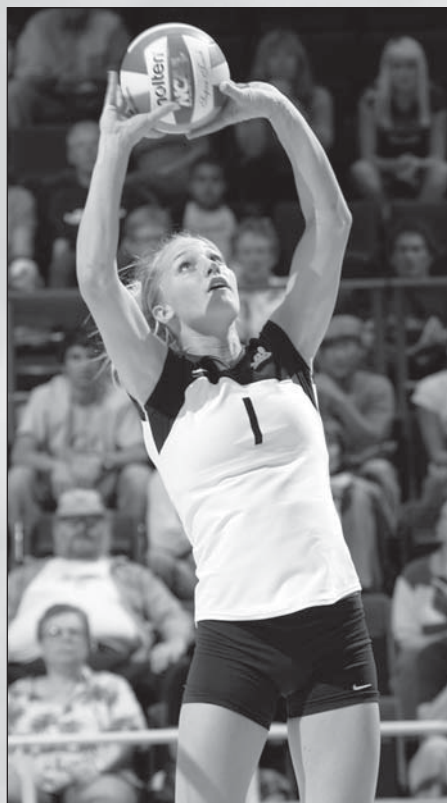

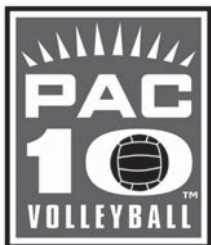

Entering the 2008-09 season, the Pacific-10 Conference continues to uphold its tradition as the "Conference of Champions."® Pac-10 members have claimed an incredible 159 NCAA team titles over the past 18 seasons, for an average of more than eight championships per academic year.

Even more impressive is the breadth of the Pac-10's success, as those 159 team titles have come in 26 different men's and women's sports. The Pac-10 has led the nation in NCAA Championships 42 of the last 48 years and finished second five times.

Spanning nearly a century of outstanding athletics achievement, the Pac-10 has captured 372 NCAA titles (259 men's, 113 women's), far outdistancing the runner-up Big Ten Conference's 217 titles.

The Pac-10 captured 13 NCAA titles in 2007-08 to lead the nation, finishing just one shy of the all-time Division I record of 14 titles, set by the Pac-10 in 1996-97. It should be noted that the Pac-10 total does not include CALIFORNIA's national championship in men's rugby or STANFORD's national championship in women's synchronized swimming, as they are not counted as NCAA titles. The Pac-10 led the nation with the most NCAA titles in women's sports with eight.

Individually, the Conference has produced an impressive number of NCAA men's individual champions as well, claiming 1,162 NCAA individual crowns.

Since the NCAA began conducting women's championships 27 years ago, Pac-10 members have claimed at least four national titles in a single season on 19 occasions. Overall, the Pac-10 has captured 113 NCAA women's crowns, easily outdistancing the SEC, which is second with 72. Pac-10 members have dominated a number of sports, winning 20 softball titles, 18 tennis crowns, 13 of the last 18 volleyball titles, 12 of the last 19 trophies in golf and 10 in swimming and diving.

Pac-10 women athletes shine nationally on an individual basis as well, having captured an unmatched 511 NCAA individual titles, an average of more than 18 championships per season.

The Pac-10 sponsors 11 men's sports and 11 women's sports. Additionally, the Conference is a member of the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) in four other men's sports and two other women's sports.

PAC-10 WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL

There is little argument that the Pacific-10 Conference is the nation's strongest in the sport of women's volleyball. Since the beginning of the NCAA Volleyball Championships in 1981, a Pac-10 institution has won the national title 13 times, and finished as runner-up on an additional 12 occasions.

Only one conference in the nation has sent each of its members to at least one NCAA Tournament - the Pac-10. The conference has routinely sent four or more representatives each season to the NCAA Tournament, topped by eight participants in 2002. Five NCAA Championship matches have featured Pac-10 teams battling each other for the national crown.

Pac-10 volleyball history dates back to 1986, when the Conference began sponsoring women's athletics. Since then, over 85 Pac-10 athletes have garnered All-America honors from the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA). Those individuals have collected over 140 All-America certificates, including eight AVCA National Player of the Year winners.

Cal has made 11 NCAA Tournament appearances (1982, '83, '87, '88, '89, '02, '03, '04, '05, '06 and '07), making the round of 16 for the first time in school history in 2003, and again in 2006 and 2007. The trip in 2007 yielded the best result yet as the Bears advanced to the NCAA championship semifinal for the first time in school history. Cal also finished fifth in the 1991 National Invitational Volleyball Championship (NIVC), and was 10th at the 1981 AIAW National Championship.
