CALIFORNIA: Enters her second season as an outside hitter for the Golden Bears...is a member of the Cal track and field team as well, competing in the 100 and 200 meters this past spring...as a **FRESHMAN** in 2004 was named first team All-Pac-10, the first Cal freshman in school history selected all-conference, and a member of the Pac-10 All-Freshman Team...was second on the Bears' squad with 329 kills (3.74 kills per game, 7th in the Pac-10)...led Cal in kills in 13 of 29 matches...was also 10th in Pac-10 in points per game (4.16)...tallied a team-high 21 kills Nov. 11 at Oregon State...had a team-high 14 kills with a career-high 20 digs versus USC Nov. 4...was named Pac-10 Player of the Week Nov. 1 after recording a career-high 25 kills with two block solos and 13 digs versus Stanford Oct. 31...had a team-high 14 kills at Washington State Oct. 23...recorded a team-high 15 kills with no errors in 27 attempts (.556) versus Oregon State Oct. 16...had 14 kills and 18 digs at USC Oct. 9...had a team-high 18 kills at Stanford Oct. 1...recorded 22 kills, a career-high 54 kill attempts and four block solos versus Arizona Sept. 24...hit .353 (18k, 6e, 34att) versus UC Irvine Sept. 19 and .345 (15k, 5e, 29att) at Hawaii Sept. 17 to earn Waikiki Beach Marriott Invitational all-tournament honors...had 12 kills with 11 digs versus Kansas State Sept. 3.

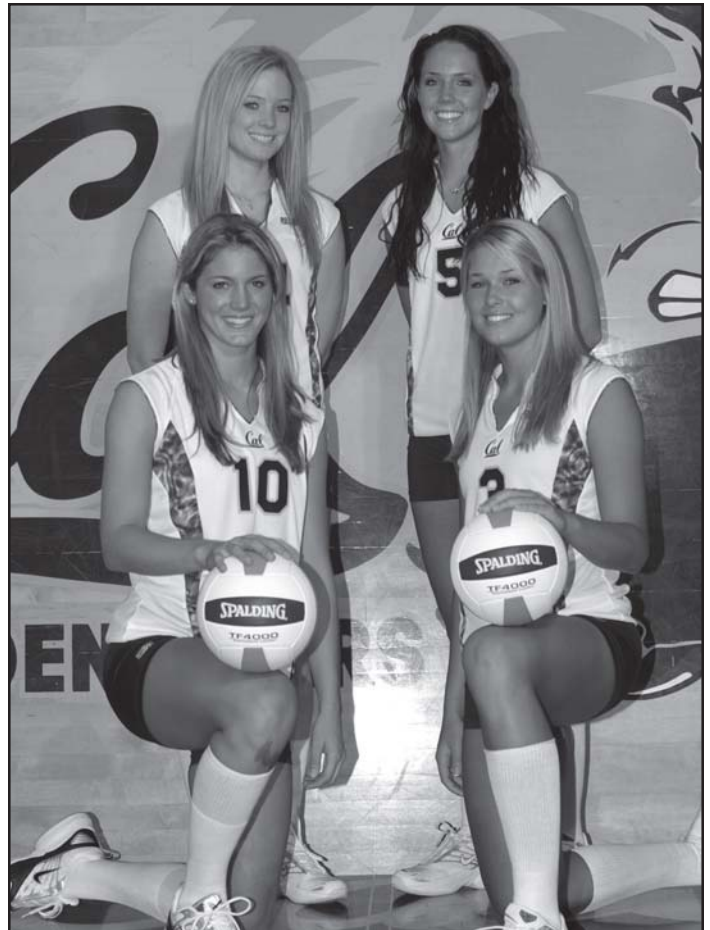
