### TEAM NOTES

- The Bears have now won 19 consecutive Pac-12 regular season games - the longest streak active streak in the conference.
- Lindsay Gottlieb remains perfect at 30-0 against non-California Pac-12 schools.
- The Bears have won eighth consecutive over Utah.
- California remains tied atop the conference standings at 4-0 in Pac-12 play.
- California improves to 14-2 all-time when playing on the Pac-12 Network.
- California now leads the all-time series, 10-4.
- California shot 76.5% (13-of-17) from the free throw line - the best single-game percentage of the Lindsay Gottlieb era.
- Cal went on runs of 7-0 and 9-0 in the first half to gain separation with a 28-15 lead and 9:39 to go in the half, but the Bears only hit three field goals in the final nine minutes of the half to take a 34-29 lead into the break.

### PLAYER NOTES

#### HIND BEN ABDELKADER • FRESHMAN • GUARD

- Matched her career-high with (1) blocked shot - last set against Lafayette.

#### BRITTANY BOYD • JUNIOR • GUARD

- Has scored at least 20 points for the second time in five Pac-12 games this season.
- Scored (24) points - one shy of her season-high of 25 set against Oregon State.
- With her (4) assists, Boyd now has (404) career assists, to move into a tie with Meme Fanner for No. 4 on the California all-time list.
- With her (3) steals, Boyd now has (233) career thefts and is (5) shy of tying Jackie Lear for No. 5 on the California all-time list.

#### GENNIFER BRANDON • SENIOR • FORWARD

- Set a season-high with (3) steals in the contest.

#### RESHANDA GRAY • JUNIOR • FORWARD

- Has scored in double figures in 13 of Cal's 14 games this season.

#### JUSTINE HARTMAN • JUNIOR • FORWARD

- Her (6) points were her most since knocking down six points against UConn (12/28).
