### TEAM NOTES

- The Bears wore bands on their jerseys in honor of Ted Agu, a California football player who passed away Friday morning in Berkeley.
- California Starters: Boyd (G), Lyles (G), Jemerigbe (G), Hartman (F), Gray (F) - the third consecutive game that Cal has used this lineup.
- Lindsay Gottlieb improves to 4-0 against Washington as the California head coach.
- The second game this season that Cal had two players with double-doubles.
- Trailing 21-18 (7:35, 1st half), California went on an 8-0 run over the next four minutes to claim the lead at 26-21 for the first time since a 2-0 advantage until the Huskies ended the run with a jumper at 3:38.
- The teams combined to go 12-of-19 from beyond the arc in the first half - California with a 6-of-10 effort and Washington with a 6-of-9 effort.
- Washington jumped to an eight-point lead (54-46) with 12:04 to go before the Bears responded with a 7-0 run to make it 54-53 (10:39, 2nd).

### PLAYER NOTES

#### BRITTANY BOYD • JUNIOR • GUARD

- Had 14 points, 9 rebounds and 9 assists to nearly become the second Golden Bear in the Pac-10/12 era to record a triple-double after Eliza Sokolowska who put up 13 points, 15 assists and 10 steals against Arizona State on Feb. 9, 1995.
- Had her second-highest assist outing of the season with (9) assists - falling (3) shy of her 12 assists dished against Bakersfield this season.
- With her (9) assists, Boyd now has (446) career assists, (24) shy of matching Natasha Vital for No. 3 on the California all-time list.
- With her (3) steals, Boyd now has (249) career thefts, (1) shy of Cynthia Cooke for No. 3 on the California all-time list.
- Boyd improves her season total to (68) steals on the year, (35) shy of Eliza Sokolowska's single-season program-best mark of 100 set in the 1994-95 season.

#### GENNIFER BRANDON • SENIOR • FORWARD

- Had her fourth consecutive Friday game with double-figures rebounding after pulling down a season-high (12) boards Friday night.
- Had her third double-double of the season with (10) points and (12) rebounds.

#### RESHANDA GRAY • JUNIOR • FORWARD

- With her (20) points, is now at (996) in her career.
- Had her eighth double-double of the season with (20) points and (12) rebounds.

#### MERCEDES JEFFLO • FRESHMAN • GUARD

- Went 1-of-1 from beyond the arc for her first three-pointer since going 1-of-2 at Utah.
- Matched her career-high with (1) blocked shot.

#### AFURE JEMERIGBE • SENIOR • GUARD

- Scored all (8) of her points in the second half.

#### MIKAYLA LYLES • SENIOR • GUARD

- Scored 12 points on 4-of-8 shooting from beyond the arc
