TEAM NOTES

- Friday night was California's Play4Kay pink game
- Prior to the game, California honored Reshanda Gray and Brittany Boyd with 1,000-point balls.
- The 49 points allowed are the least amount allowed by the Bears in a game this season - besting the 51 points that Cal allowed in wins against Long Beach State, Northwestern and Bakersfield.
- California evens the all-time series at 29-29 against Arizona.
- California has now won 15 consecutive games against the Wildcats - Cal's second longest active streak against a conference opponent.
- Lindsay Gottlieb improves to 34-1 all-time against non-California based Pac-12 schools.
- California opened the game on a 7-0 run, but the Wildcats responded with a 10-0 run of their own. The Bears then went on another 7-0 run to make it 14-10.
- Every Golden Bear on the roster played in Friday night's game.
- California Starters: Boyd (G), Lyles (G), Jemerigbe (G), Hartman (F), Gray (F) - the fifth consecutive game that Cal has used this lineup.

PLAYER NOTES

BRITTANY BOYD • JUNIOR • GUARD

- With her (6) assists, Boyd now has (457) career assists, (13) shy of matching Natasha Vital for No. 3 on the California all-time list.
- With her (2) steals, Boyd now has (254) career thefts, (32) shy of matching Courtney Johnson for No. 2 on the California all-time list.
- Boyd improves her season total to (73) steals on the year, (30) shy of Eliza Sokolowska's single-season program-best mark of 100 set in the 1994-95 season.

GENNIFER BRANDON • SENIOR • FORWARD

- Moved to No. 9 on the Pac-12 all-time rebounding list with her (9) boards Friday night. Brandon, who has (1139) career rebounds, passed UCLA's Natalie Williams (1137) and Stanford's Val Whiting (1134) on the all-time list.

RESHANDA GRAY • JUNIOR • FORWARD

- Posted her 10th double-double of the season and third consecutive with (16) points and (11) rebounds.
- Blocked a shot for the first time since rejecting a season-high two shots against UConn (Dec. 22, 2013).
- Matched her career-high with (2) assists.
- Made her first seven attempts from the field and finished 7-of-10.

JUSTINE HARTMAN • JUNIOR • FORWARD

- Matched her season-high with (1) blocked shot - last set at Arizona earlier this season.
- Matched her career-high with (1) steal - last set against USC.

MERCEDES JEFFLO • FRESHMAN • GUARD

- Matched her Pac-12 career-high with (3) steals in the game.
- Matched her career-high with (1) blocked shot - last set at Arizona in Tucson.

MIKAYLA LYLES • SENIOR • GUARD

- Has scored 41 points in Cal's last four games.

KC WATERS • FRESHMAN • FORWARD

- Matched her career-high with (1) rebound - last set against Northwestern.
