TEAM NOTES

- California falls to 0-3 in Pac-12 Tournament finals, losing all three games to Stanford (2008, 2012, 2015)
- Stanford is now 7-0 all-time against the Golden Bears in the Pac-12 Tournament
- Lindsay Gottlieb moves to 5-4 in Pac-12 Tournament games
- Just the second time this season that Brittany Boyd and Reshanda Gray have both been held under 10 points scoring in the same game (last vs Washington State on Feb. 2)
- The teams both pulled down 32 rebounds
- California made more field goal's in the game (25 to 22) but only made five free throws (5-of-11) to Stanford's 14 (14-of-17)
- California first loss on a neutral court this season
- Brittany Boyd and Reshanda Gray have both played in 131 career games - 8th-most in California women's basketball history.

PLAYER NOTES

BRITTANY BOYD • SENIOR • GUARD

- Left the first half with 16:01 remaining and returned with 2:22 in the game after getting cut on her right cheek
- With her (7) points, Boyd has (1666) in her career, holding steady at No. 7 on the California record book.
- With her (3) assists, Boyd has (718) in her career, just (53) assists shy of matching Jennifer Azzi of Stanford for No. 2 on the Pac-12 all-time assists list.
- With her (4) steals, Boyd has (364) in her career, the most for an active player in the NCAA.

PENINA DAVIDSON • FRESHMAN • FORWARD

- Matched her career-high with (2) steals

RESHANDA GRAY • SENIOR • FORWARD

- With her (6) points, Gray has (1740) in her career and is (26) points shy of cracking Cal's all-time top five.
- With her (3) rebounds, Gray has (902) in her career, holding steady at No. 5 on the California all-time rebounds list.

MERCEDES JEFFLO • SOPHOMORE • GUARD

- Scored (16) points to finish the Pac-12 Tournament averaging 14 points per game in contests against Washington, Colorado and Stanford

COURTNEY RANGE • SOPHOMORE • FORWARD

- Her (17) points scored are her most since she went down and missed seven games to injury beginning on Dec. 7, 2014.
- Pulled down (9) rebounds, her second-most this season
